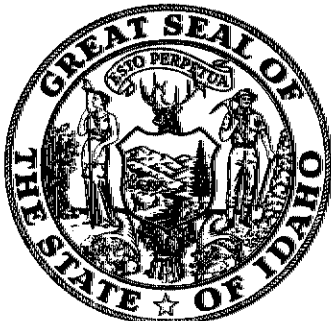

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF THE PLUMMER/WORLEY FRIENDS OF THE  
LIBRARY, INC.

ARTICLE I

Name and Duration

Section 1: The name of this organization shall be  
THE PLUMMER/WORLEY FRIENDS OF THE LIBRARY, INC.

Section 2: The duration of the corporation shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE II

Location/Address

The principal office of the corporation shall be located in the  
City of Plummer, Benewah County, Idaho. That address shall be  
Corner of 8th and D Streets, P.O. Box 309, Plummer, Idaho, 83851.  
The registered agent at that address shall be Paulina Freeburg.

ARTICLE III

Purpose

In furtherance of, and, except as otherwise expressly provided  
herein, not in limitation of the general powers conferred by the  
laws of the State of Idaho, this corporation shall have the  
following purposes and powers:

1. To foster closer relations between the Plummer Public Library and  
the citizens of Plummer and Worley and environs; to promote  
knowledge of the functions, services and needs of the Library; to  
lead in the development of a program for the extension and  
improvement of the Library services and resources; to aid in the  
provision of adequate housing and other facilities for the Library;  
to assist in bringing to the Library funds for special needs beyond  
the command of the Library Budget; to encourage gifts of books and  
manuscripts; and to cooperate with the Library Director and The  
Library Board of Trustees in the development of the resources of  
the Library.

2. To have and exercise all powers, privileges and rights  
authorized by the laws of the State of Idaho, and all powers and  
rights incident thereto, except that the organization shall make no  
profits for itself from any of its activities, but all of its  
operations shall be for charitable and educational purposes, and  
shall be expressly limited to activities permitted to be carried on  
by a corporation exempt from Federal Income Tax under the  
provisions of Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of  
the United States of America of 1986 (or the corresponding  
provision of any future United States Revenue Law).

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ARTICLE IV

ARTICLE V  
Provisions for Regulation and Conduct of the Affairs of the Corporation

No part of the net earnings or assets of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, its members, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered, and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article III hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of a candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from Federal Income Tax under section 501 (c) (3) or the Internal Revenue Law, or (b) by a corporation contributions to which are deductible under section 170 (c) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law).

ARTICLE VI  
Management

The management of the corporation shall be vested in a Board of Directors: the number of the Directors shall not be less than five (5), and the qualifications, terms of office, manner of election, times and places of meetings, and powers and duties of Directors shall be as prescribed by the By-Laws of the corporation.

ARTICLE VII

Membership

The corporation shall have one class of members designated as voting members. The qualifications and rights of the members shall be set forth in the By-Laws of the corporation.

ARTICLE VIII

Amendment of Articles of Incorporation

The corporation reserves the right to amend, alter, change or repeal any provision contained in these Articles of Incorporation in the manner now or hereinafter prescribed by the laws of the State of Idaho, and all rights conferred upon the members of the corporation herein are granted subject to this reservation.

ARTICLE IX

Dissolution of the Corporation

In the event of the dissolution of the corporation, the Board of Directors shall, after paying or making provision for the payment of all of the liabilities of the corporation, shall distribute the net assets to: Plummer Public Library, Plummer, Idaho (or to an exempt organization under Section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986).
