The undersigned, acting as incorporator under the Idaho Nonprofit Corporation Act ("Act"), hereby adopts the following Articles of Incorporation for such Corporation:

- The name of the Corporation is FOUNDATION FOR BULLDOG 1. FUTURES, INC.
 - 2. **NONPROFIT:** This is a nonprofit corporation.
 - 3. **DURATION:** The duration of the Corporation shall be perpetual.
- 4. PURPOSES: To establish and operate a nonprofit corporation organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educational, and/or scientific purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended from time to time, including, but not limited to, the following:
- By augmenting the educational opportunities of all students who reside within the boundaries of, or are associated with providing public education within, Rockland School District 382 ("RSD 382") through awarding of grants or direct monies to finance educational opportunities for students, academic faculty and staff of RSD 382 through and including, without limitation, providing state of the art technical educational modes, methods and facilities within RSD 382, providing relevant and timely trade school opportunities to support a diverse economy, and assisting RSD 382 academic faculty and staff to obtain post graduate degrees, so as to expand education opportunities and provide a stronger educational base for RSD 382 students and provide for their successful futures; and
- В. By making grants, gifts, or distributions to other tax-exempt organizations under the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended from time to time, whose nonprofit, charitable and/or educational purposes are related to the purposes listed above in subsection A; and
- C. By performing all things incidental to, or appropriate in, the achievement of its nonprofit purposes, including receiving, administering, and expending public or private funds for such purposes.

- 5. <u>POWERS</u>: The Corporation shall be authorized to do any and all acts and things, and to exercise any and all powers which it may now or hereafter may be lawful for the Corporation to do or exercise under the Act to accomplish any of the purposes enumerated in Paragraph 4 hereof. Notwithstanding any of the provisions enumerated herein, this corporation shall not, except to an insubstantial degree, engage in any activities or exercise any powers that are not in furtherance of the purposes of this Corporation.
- shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, its directors, officers, or other private persons except that the Corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Paragraph 4 hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the Corporation shall be for the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provisions of these Articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended from time to time, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.
 - 7. <u>MEMBERSHIP</u>: The Corporation shall not have members.
- 8. REGISTERED OFFICE AND AGENT: The address of the initial registered office of the corporation is 2882 E. Fork Rd., Rockland, Idaho 83271, and the name of the initial registered agent of the corporation is Kip Wilson.
- 9. <u>BY LAWS</u>: Provisions for the regulation of the internal affairs of the Corporation shall be set forth in By Laws of the corporation as may be adopted by its incorporator or the initial board of directors.
- 10. **ELECTION OF DIRECTORS:** Directors of the Corporation shall be appointed and/or elected in the manner provided by the By Laws.

11. <u>INITIAL DIRECTORS</u>: The authorized number of directors of the Corporation may range between three (3) and eleven (11). Initially, the Corporation shall have Five Directors. The number of Directors may be changed from time to time, by the Board of Directors (as provided in the By Laws). 
