CORPORATION REINSTATEMENT CERTIFICATE

I, GEO. H. CURTIS, Secretary of State of the State of Idaho, and legal custodian of the corporation records of the State and collector of the annual corporation tax, do hereby certify that

FALL RIVER IRRIGATION COMPANY

a corporation
organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Idaho,
with its principal place of business in Idaho located at Wilford, Idaho,
forfeited on the ^{first} day of December, 1915, its charter
or authority to do business in the State of Idaho, because of failure to pay the annual
license tax and penalty due the State of Idaho for the fiscal year ending June 30th,
1916, as provided by Section 29-607, Idaho Code, Annotated.

AND I FURTHER CERTIFY, That the said corporation has subsequently and on the
10th day of February, 1944, paid the annual license tax and
penalty assessed against it and the said FALL RIVER IRRIGATION COMPANY
is therefore reinstated on the records of this office, and all the corporate rights
which it enjoyed under the Constitution and Laws of the State of Idaho prior to the
date of said forfeiture, are hereby restored.
