That affiant Paul Moseley, Jr. is the Chairman of the Official Board of the First Christian Church of Twin Falls, a corporation, and that affiant John Parish is the Clerk of said Board and of the membership of said corporation.

That at the regular meeting of all members of said corporation and in accordance with the notice attached hereto the Chairman of the Official Board called the meeting to order and the following proposed amendment to Article II of the Articles of Incorporation was proposed and put to a vote of all members, to-wit:

ARTICLE II.

The purpose of this corporation shall be the maintenance of said First Christian Church of Twin Falls, Idaho, the establishment of other churches, and customary and suitable organizations for religious worship, religious training and the dissemination of the teachings of the Holy Scriptures.

Furthermore, it shall continue to work toward restoring the church as set forth in the New Testament as to name, creed, doctrine, government and life as has been the purpose of the brotherhood known as Christian Churches or Churches of Christ for over 150 years.

Furthermore, the purpose shall be to help evangelize the world.

Furthermore, the purpose shall be to build up the local members of said First Christian Church of Twin Falls, Idaho.

The corporation shall have the power to acquire, own and sell or lease real estate for the purpose of the corporation; but the corporation shall not engage in any business, trade, avocation or profession for gain or profit. The corporation shall have the power and authority to own, hold, control and improve sufficient real and personal property upon and from which to construct and maintain churches, parsonages, schools and other suitable buildings in furtherance of said purposes, with power to sell, let, convey, exchange and mortgage said property and to execute notes and other contracts for the purchase, building, maintaining, improving and caring for same. This corporation shall have all the powers, privileges and rights necessary or convenient for carrying out the purposes

for which this association is formed; and the members hereby claim for this corporation all of the benefits, privileges, rights and powers created, given, extended or conferred by the provisions of Title 30, Idaho Code, or any additions or amendments thereto pertaining to non-profit co-operative associations.

As has been the practice for over 150 years of that religious body of people known as Christian Churches or Churches of Christ, the said First Christian Church of Twin Falls, Idaho, under the Lordship of Christ, shall continue to be autonomous in relation to all other religious bodies. No person or persons outside the local church membership of said First Christian Church of Twin Falls, Idaho, shall ever exercise any authority over or within the said corporation.

The said First Christian Church of Twin Falls, Idaho, shall have fellowship with all others who hold beliefs similar to our historic beliefs. We shall continue to co-operate with other congregations of Christians when we believe that by so doing the cause of Christ can be advanced, and especially with congregations that are a part of the nineteenth century religious movement known as Christian Churches or Churches of Christ that are a part of the religious movement known as "The Restoration Movement" and who also practice local autonomy under the headship of Christ.
