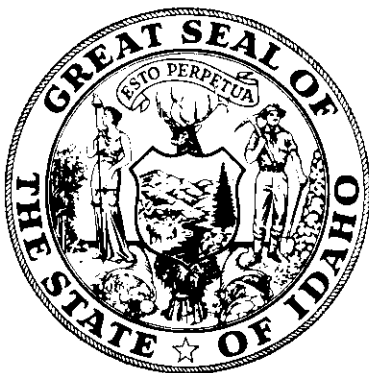

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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF
SECRETARY OF
R & **STATE** EQUIPMENT, INC.

The undersigned, acting as incorporators of a corporation under the Idaho Business Corporation Act, adopt the following Articles of Incorporation for this corporation.

I

The name of this corporation shall be R & H EQUIPMENT, INC.

II

The period of existence and duration of the life of this corporation shall be perpetual.

III

The address of the initial registered office of this corporation is 7725 Stackrock Drive, Boise, Idaho 83703, and the name of the initial registered agent at such address is CHARLES F. RICH.

IV

The nature of the business and the object and purpose of this corporation shall be as follows:

(a) Owning, managing and operating an equipment business; the sale, leasing, servicing of equipment.

(b) The transaction of any or all other lawful business for which corporations may be incorporated under the Idaho Business Corporation Act.

V

That the total authorized number of par value shares of this corporation shall be one million, all of one class, each of a par

value of \$1.00, which said shares shall be common stock and shall not be subject to assessment.
