ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

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SAVE OUR SNAKE, INC.

The undersigned, acting as incorporators of a corporation under Title 30, Chapter 3, Idaho Code - Idaho Nonprofit Corporation Act, adopt the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation:

FIRST: The name of the corporation is SAVE OUR SNAKE, INC.

SECOND: The corporation is a non-stock non-profit corporation.

THIRD: The period of duration is perpetual.

FOURTH: The corporation is organized for the purpose of educating ourselves and the public to the benefits of the free-flowing sections of the Snake River and the potential harm which could come to the local inhabitants, both human and animal, if said free-flowing river is dammed up. The corporation will provide facts, figures and research data through free public forums and any other forms of communication deemed necessary for the education of the general public, thereby qualifying said corporation for tax-exempt status under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law).

FIFTH: A member of the corporation shall be anyone who desires to support said corporation and further its purpose. Said members shall elect a board of directors, which board shall govern the affairs of said corporation.

SIXTH: Meetings of the members of this corporation shall be held at such place and such time as the board of directors shall designate.

SEVENTH: No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, its members, directors, officers or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article Four hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall consist of the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf or any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from Federal Income Tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law) or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law).

EIGHTH: Upon the dissolution of the corporation, the Board of Directors shall, after paying or making provisions for the payment of all of the liabilities of the corporation, dispose of all of the assets of the corporation exclusively for the purpose of the corporation in such manner, or to such organization or organizations and operated exclusively for charitable, educational, religious, or scientific purposes as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law) as the Board of Directors shall determine.

NINTH: The corporation reserves the right to amend, alter, change or repeal any provision contained in these Articles of Incorporation, in the manner now or heareafter prescribed by Statute, and all rights conferred upon members herein are granted subject to their reservation.

TENTH: The address of the initial principal office of the corporation is 644 East 1500 North, Shelley, Idaho 83274, and the name of its initial registered agent at such address is Brent E. Long.

ELEVENTH: The number of directors constituting the initial Board of Directors of the corporation is nine, and the names and addresses of the persons who are to serve as the initial directors are:
