ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

CARIBOU COUNTY DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION

The undersigned, acting as incorporator of a corporation under the Idaho Nonprofit Corporation Act, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation:

 \underline{FIRST} : The name of the corporation is CARIBOU COUNTY DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION.

SECOND: The period of its duration is perpetual.

THIRD: The corporation is a nonprofit corporation.

FOURTH: This corporation is organized exclusively for the following purposes:

- (a) To foster economic development in Caribou County, Idaho, and to receive, administer and expend funds for such purpose.
- (b) To engage in any nonprofit activity that may be lawfully undertaken by a corporation organized under Idaho Code, Section 30-301, et seq.
- (c) To engage in all such activities as are incidental or conducive to the attainment of the purposes of this corporation, and to do such acts and things and exercise any and all powers authorized or permitted to be done by a corporation under any laws that may be now or hereafter applicable or available to this corporation.

FIFTH: In lieu of capital stock, the corporation shall issue membership certificates to representatives from public and private sectors of Caribou County in such numbers and proportions as prescribed in the By-Laws.

SIXTH: No dividends shall be paid and no part of the income shall be distributed to members, directors or officers of the corporation. The corporation may compensate or reimburse its members, directors, officers or employees for reasonable expenditures.

This corporation shall use its funds only for the purposes stated in these Articles, and no part of the funds shall inure to the personal benefit of or be distributed to the members of the corporation or directors, except compensation, expense reimbursement or salaries to officers and employees.

In the event this corporation should be dissolved, the net assets remaining shall be distributed to one or more qualified charitable, educational, scientific or public entity; providing that said entity meets the rules and regulations of the Internal Revenue Service for the United States, and selection thereof shall be by the Board of Directors of the corporation.

SEVENTH: The members of the corporation shall not be personally liable for liabilities or obligations of the corporation.

EIGHTH: These Articles may be amended by two-thirds (2/3) majority vote of the membership at any annual meeting or any special meeting appropriately called for such purpose.
