corporations. (Article XI, Section 7, Constitution of Idaho).

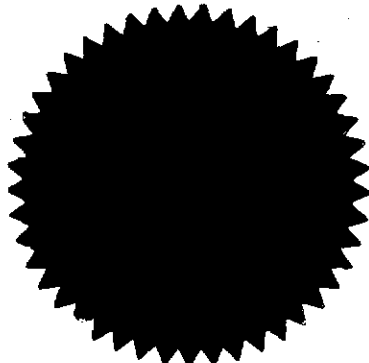
