ELEMENTS THERAPEUTIC MASSAGE, INC.

The undersigned, acting as Incorporator of a corporation under the Idaho Business Corporation Act, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation:

FIRST: The name of the corporation is ELEMENTS THERAPEUTIC MASSAGE, INC.

SECOND: The period of its duration is perpetual, unless dissolved by action of the stockholders or by operation of law.

THIRD: The purpose or purposes for which the corporation is organized are: to provide therapeutic massage services to the general public, and to sell any goods, services or products related to general health care, and the transaction of any or all lawful business for which corporations may be incorporated under the Idaho Business Corporation Act.

FOURTH: The corporation shall have authority to issue 1000 shares of stock, all of one class, with no par value.

FIFTH: Provisions denying preemptive rights are: NONE.

SIXTH: Provisions for the regulation of the internal affairs of the corporation are: NONE.

SEVENTH: The address of the initial registered office of the corporation is 2820 S. Island Drive, Nampa, Idaho 83686, and the name of its initial registered agent at such address is LARRY McMILLIN.

EIGHTH: The number of directors constituting the initial Board of Directors of the corporation is two (2), and the name and address of the persons who are to serve as Directors until the first annual meeting of shareholders or until successors are elected and shall qualify are:


