ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that I, the undersigned, being a natural person of full age and a citizen of the United States, in order to form a corporation for the purposes hereinafter stated, pursuant to the Idaho Business Corporation Act, as set forth in Title 30, Idaho Code, Volume 5B, do hereby certify as follows:

I.

The name of the Corporation is PRECISION DELIVERY SYSTEMS, INC.

II.

The purposes for which the Corporation is organized are:

1. To manufacture, lease and sell asphalt patching hydraulic augers and any and all other equipment and accessories necessary for the successful operation of the augers.
2. To engage in the transaction of any or all lawful business for which corporations may be incorporated under this act, Title 30, Idaho Code, Volume 5B.

III.

This Corporation shall have all the power, authority and capacity set forth in the Idaho Business Corporation Act as now enacted or hereafter amended, including but not limited to the following:

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

1. To sue and be sued, complain and defend in its corporate name.

2. To have a corporate seal which may be altered at pleasure, and to use the same by causing it, or a facsimile thereof, to be impressed or affixed or in any other manner reproduced.

3. To purchase, lease, use, and dispose of all equipment, machinery, tools and apparatus necessary or convenient in and about the prosecution of its business.

4. To purchase, lease, or otherwise acquire, own, hold, improve, use, and otherwise deal in and with real and personal property, or any interest therein, wherever situate.

5. To sell, convey, mortgage, pledge, lease, exchange, transfer, and otherwise dispose of all or part of its property and assets.

6. To purchase, own, hold, vote, use, sell, mortgage, lend, pledge, or otherwise dispose of, and otherwise use and deal in and with shares or other interests in, or obligations of, other domestic or foreign corporations, associations, partnerships, or individuals, or direct or indirect obligations of the United States or of any other government, state, territory, governmental district or municipality or of any instrumentality thereof.

7. To make contracts and guarantees and incur liabilities, borrow money at such rates of interest as the corporation may determine, issue its notes, bond, and other

obligations, and secure any of its obligations by mortgage or pledge of all or any of its property, franchises and income.

8. To lend money for its corporate purposes, invest and reinvest its funds, and take and hold real and personal property as security for the payment of funds so loaned or invested.

9. To conduct its business, carry on its operations and have offices and exercise the powers granted by this Act, within or without the United States of America.

10. To elect or appoint officers and agents of the corporation, and define their duties and fix their compensation.

11. To make and alter bylaws, not inconsistent with its articles of incorporation or with the laws of this state, for the administration and regulation of the affairs of the corporation.

12. To pay pensions and establish pension plans, pension trusts, profit sharing plans, stock bonus plans, stock option plans and other incentive plans for any or all of its directors, officers, and employees.

13. To be a promoter, partner, member, associate, or manager of any partnership, joint venture, trust or other enterprise.

14. To have and exercise all powers necessary or convenient to effect its purposes.

IV.

The Corporation shall have perpetual existence.

V.

The location of the initial registered office of the corporation is 918 Wingate Drive, Pocatello, Idaho, 83201, and Michael E. Miller shall serve as the intial registered agent of the corporation.

VI.

The aggregate number of shares of which the corporation shall have authority to issue is 15,000 common shares without par value.

VII.

There shall be no Board of Directors as provided in Idaho Code §30-1-35. The business and affairs of the corporation shall be managed by the officers of the Corporation who shall have all powers and duties that otherwise would be conferred or imposed upon the Board of Directors under the Idaho Business Corporation Act.

VIII.

The name and post office address of the president of the Corporation, who shall serve until the first meeting of shareholders, or until his successor has been duly elected and qualified is Michael E. Miller whose address is 918 Wingate Drive, Pocatello, Idaho, 83201.

IX.

The name and address of the incorporator is Michael E. Miller, 918 Wingate Drive, Pocatello, Idaho, 83201.

X.

These Articles of Incorporation may be modified or amended from time to time by an affirmative vote of a majority of the record corporate shareholders at a meeting duly called pursuant to law.


