ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

THE GRAPEVINE CLUB, INC.

We, the undersigned, being natural persons of full age and citizens of the United States and of the State of Idaho, do hereby associate ourselves together to form a non-profit cooperative association under and pursuant to Chapter 10 of Title 30, Idaho Code, and do hereby certify as follows:

I.

The name of this association is THE GRAPEVINE CLUB, INC.

II.

The purpose and objects for which this association is formed are, without pecuniary profit to cultivate social intercourse among its members, and to inculcate the principles of better living, < good citizenship, charity, justice, brotherly love and fidelity, and to promote the welfare and enhance the happiness of its members, and to that end to lease, purchase, hold, have, use and take possession of andenjoy in fee simple or otherwise any personal or real property necessary for the uses and purposes of the corporation, and to sell, lease, deed in trust, mortgage, alien or dispose of the same at the pleasure of the corporation, and for the uses and purposes for which said corporation is formed, and to buy and sell real or personal property and to apply the proceeds of sale, including any and all income, to the uses and purposes of the corporation, and to do all acts that societies and associations whose object is not pecuniary profit, but is to promote the general interest and welfare of the members, may do under the laws of the State of Idaho.

III.

The duration of this association shall be perpetual.

IV.

The location and post office address of this association's registered office in this State is Boise, Idaho.

This association shall have no capital stock. Any citizen of the United States and any corporation or association, mentioned in Section 30-1003, Idaho Code, may become a member of this association under such rules and regulations as the Board of Directors of this association may from time to time establish. Certificates of membership shall be issued to each member of this association, which certificates cannot be assigned so that the transferee thereof can by such transfer become a member of such association, except by resolution of the Board of Directors and under such regulation as the By-Laws may prescribe.

VI.

The business of this association shall be managed and conducted by a Board of Directors consisting of five persons and / by such executive officers as may be appointed by said Board of Directors to carry on said business under and by virtue of any By-Laws which may from time to time be adopted by this association.

VII.

By-Laws providing for the management and control of the affair s of the corporation may be adopted by the directors, and, from time to time, they may alter, amend or repeal any by-laws: but any by-laws made by the Board of Directors may be altered or repealed by a two-thirds vote of the members at any regular meeting, or at any special meeting, provided notice of such proposed alteration or repeal by the members be included in the notice of such special meeting.

Members of said club and association shall be received and removed, and the authorized number and qualifications of members of this corporation, the different classes of membership, if any, the property, voting and other rights and privileges of each class of membership, and the liability of each or all classes to dues or assessments, and the method of collection thereof, shall be as

set forth in the by-laws of this corporation, and there shall be issued to each member a certificate of membership as provided by said by-laws.
