The undersigned, being over 18 years of age and a citizen of the United States of America, hereby forms the following corporation pursuant to the Idaho Business Corporation Act.

I

The name of the corporation is Uranius Pelican, Inc.

II

The period of its duration is perpetual.

III

The sole and specific purpose for which the corporation is organized is to engage in the business of developing, testing, producing and marketing specialty items for resale.

IV

The aggregate number of shares which the corporation shall have authority to issue is 5,000 shares, all one class, and of \$1.00 par value.
