is duly recorded in Book **A-35** of Record of Domestic Corporations of the State of Idaho,
and that the said articles contain the statement of facts required by Sections 29-103, 29-1101 and
29-1102, Idaho Code, Annotated.

AND I FURTHER CERTIFY, That the persons executing the articles and their associates
and successors are hereby constituted a corporation, by the name stated in the articles, and for
perpetual existence from the date hereof, with its registered office in this State located
at **Lewiston** in the County of **Ben Pecos**,
and as such are subject to the rights, privileges and limitations granted to Religious, Ex-Service
Men, Benevolent, Charitable and Fraternal Corporations, as provided in Chapter 11, Title 29,
Idaho Code, Annotated.

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

of

THE CHRISTIAN AND MISSIONARY ALLIANCE CHURCH, INC.,
A RELIGIOUS CORPORATION

We, the undersigned, being all citizens of the United States and residents of Lewiston in Nez Perce County in said state, and being all members of The Christian and Missionary Alliance Church of Lewiston, Idaho, hereby associate ourselves together for the purpose of forming a religious corporation pursuant to Chapter 11 of Title 29 of Idaho Code Annotated 1932 and acts supplemental thereto and amendatory thereof, and we do hereby certify:

That at a meeting of the members of said church held in The Christian and Missionary Alliance Church located at the corner of Fifteenth Street and Sixth Avenue in the City of Lewiston, Nez Perce County, Idaho, at the hour of eight o'clock P.M., on the Tenth day of November, 1942, for the purpose of forming a religious corporation of the members of said church under the name of The Christian and Missionary Alliance Church, Inc., a religious corporation, providing that said corporation shall have perpetual succession, adopting by-laws for said corporation and electing three (3) trustees thereof, and for the purpose of transacting any and all other business that the members present deemed it expedient to transact in connection with the incorporation of said church, prior to which meeting and election notice of the time and place thereof was given in the manner and form required by law, by publication for at least two (2) weeks in the Lewiston Tribune, a daily newspaper of general circulation printed and published in the City of Lewiston, Nez Perce County, Idaho, a copy of which notice as printed and published is hereto attached, marked "Exhibit A" and by reference made a part hereof, and by posting a like notice in a conspicuous place on the building where such meeting and election was held for the same length of time, at which

meeting there were nineteen (19) members of said church present, the undersigned were elected trustees of said church to hold office until the election and qualification of their successors at the first annual meeting of said church thereafter, and were authorized to adopt and certify the following Articles of Incorporation, to-wit:

ARTICLE I.
(Name)

The name of this corporation shall be "THE CHRISTIAN AND MISSIONARY ALLIANCE CHURCH, INC."

ARTICLE II.
(Term)

The term of existence of this corporation is unlimited and it shall have perpetual succession and existence from and after the date of incorporation.

ARTICLE III.
(Purposes)

The purposes for which this corporation is formed are as follows:

To promote the cause of the Christian religion; to promulgate the doctrines and teachings of The Christian and Missionary Alliance, a corporation organized under the laws of the State of New York, with which Society this corporation is affiliated and connected as a subordinate body, and should said Society cease to exist as a corporate body in affiliation, cooperation or connection with the said parent Society; viz., The Christian and Missionary Alliance, having its principal office at number 260 West 44th Street, Borough of Manhattan, City, County and State of New York, and subject to its purposes, usages, doctrines and teachings, then all the real and personal property, appurtenances and effects then owned by this Society shall revert and enure to said The Christian and Missionary Alliance of New York., N. Y., or to the incorporated or supervising body of The Christian and Missionary Alliance within whose jurisdiction said corporation is located or with which it is affiliated, as provided by law; to provide for its members a place of worship, to be conducted in accordance with the rules and laws of The Christian and Missionary Alliance of New York, a corporation organized under the laws of the State of New York; to purchase or otherwise

acquire, hold, manage, sell, mortgage and otherwise encumber or dispose of real or personal property of any kind whatsoever; to receive, hold and enjoy gifts, devises and legacies; to borrow money, to execute and issue notes and bonds evidencing its indebtedness, and to secure indebtedness by pledge, mortgage or other encumbrance of its property; to rent and lease real property; to do any and all things convenient and incidental to the purposes herein expressed, and generally to have and exercise all such powers as are by law conferred on corporations of like character, and without in any particular limiting any of the objects or purposes or powers of the corporation, the objectives and purposes of the corporation shall be from time to time to do any one or more or all of the acts and things herein set forth, and all such acts, things and business in any manner connected therewith or necessary, incidental, convenient or auxiliary thereto or calculated, directly or indirectly, to promote the interests of the corporation or the members thereof, or enhance the value of any of its property or rights, as such corporation, may lawfully do; and in carrying on its objectives and purposes, or for the purpose of attaining any of its objects, to do any and all things and exercise any and all other powers not prohibited by law.

ARTICLE IV.
(Principal Office)

The place where the principal office of this corporation shall be maintained and its principal place of business is at Lewiston, Nez Perce County, Idaho, and the postoffice and registered address of this corporation in the State of Idaho shall be Lewiston, Nez Perce County, Idaho.

ARTICLE V.
(Membership)

The members of this corporation shall be all persons who now are or may hereafter become members of The Christian and Missionary Alliance Church of Lewiston, Idaho, under the rules and manual of The Christian and Missionary Alliance, a New York corporation, as embodied and set

forth in the Manual of The Christian and Missionary Alliance published by the authority of said Alliance in the year 1941, and any amendments or additions thereto.

ARTICLE VI.
(Trustees)

The number of Trustees of this corporation shall be three (3). Such trustees shall have charge of the management of the real property of this corporation and the promotion, operation and management thereof, and shall have charge of and the management of all church property for the use of the members of this corporation and the properly constituted church authorities. The qualifications and terms of office, manner of election, time, place and manner of calling meetings and any other powers and duties of the trustees shall be prescribed by the by-laws.

That the following persons were elected on November 10, 1942, to serve as trustees until the first annual meeting of the members of this corporation thereafter and until their successors are elected and qualified: Lee McPherson, Orville Roe and Rolf H. Hansen.
