Change ARTICLE I, Section 1.

Section 1.

The name of the Association shall be the Idaho Rental Owners and Managers Association, Inc.

Add the following new Section 3.

to Article I

Section 3. These Bylaws shall govern the operation of this association. If there is no action referenced in the Bylaws or if there is a conflict between these Bylaws and the laws of the state of Idaho as expressed in Title 30. Chapter 30, Idaho Nonprofit Corporation Act, then the laws of the state of Idaho shall prevail.

Change Article IV, Sections 1. and 3. and ARTICLE XI

ARTICLE IV

Section 1.

The Association shall hold an <u>annual</u> meeting in <u>December at which the election of officers will take place. The Association shall hold an educational/social meeting each month. The Association shall hold a regular business meeting prior to the educational/social meeting in <u>January</u>. April. August, and <u>November</u>. Day, hour, and place of meetings to be determined by the Board of Directors. All members in good standing must be notified by first class mail of the day, place and time of any meeting no fewer than ten (10) nor more than sixty (60) days before the meeting. Notification must include a description of any matter or matters that must be approved by the members under Idaho Code section 30-3-81, 30-3-88, 30-3-91, 30-3-97, 30-3-103, 30-3-107, or 30-3-112.</u>

Section 3.

Special meetings of the Association may be called by the written request of 10% of the voting members in good standing by signing, dating and delivering to any Officer one or more written demands for the meeting describing the purpose or purposes for which it is to be held. If notice for a special meeting is not given as required by section 1, above within thirty (30) days after the date the written demand or demands are delivered to an Officer, the person signing the demand or demands may set the time and place of the meeting and give notice as required by Section 1, above.

ARTICLE XI

Robert's Rules of Order shall govern the conduct of all meetings of the Association in all cases where they are applicable and at times where they do not conflict with the Bylaws of the Association or Title 30. Chapter 30, Idaho Nonprofit Corporation Act.
