

1 Certificate of Incorporation of the
2 Idaho Land and Irrigation Company 17

3 I know all men by these presents,
4 That we, whose names are subscribed
5 hereto, do hereby certify that we have as-
6 sociated ourselves together as a corporation
7 under the laws of the Territory of Idaho, for
8 the purpose of doing business in said Ter-
9 ritory as hereinafter stated.

10 1st The name of said corporation by which
11 it shall be known, and under which it
12 shall transact its business and exercise
13 its corporate powers, shall be "The Idaho
14 Land and Irrigation Company"

15 2nd The object for which ^{the} Company is
16 formed is to dig, own and maintain wa-
17 ter ditches in said Territory of Idaho, in
18 such numbers and in such locations
19 as it may deem advisable; direct thereto
20 from living and natural water courses
21 streams and springs, water and sell or
22 otherwise dispose of and utilize the same
23 in the reclamation of arid lands and
24 for such other uses and purposes as may
25 be deemed practicable and advisable; acquire
26 and reclaim waste lands and cultivate
27 improve and sell and otherwise dispose
28 of the same as may be deemed advisable
29 by the Company; also to engage in the
30 breeding and growing of live stock of all
31 kinds and buy and sell the same also
32 to engage in manufacturing business

1 buying selling and working mines
2 of all kinds and in lumbering busi-
3 =ness and all all other kinds of business
4 necessary to carry into effect the objects
5 of said Corporation and effectuate the pur-
6 =poses of its organization as shall become
7 necessary for the best interests of said
8 Corporation.

9 3^d The amount of Capital stock of said
10 Company shall be Five Million Dollars di-
11 =vided into Fifty Thousand Shares of One-
12 =hundred Dollars each

13 4th The number of trustees of said
14 corporation, who shall manage the concerns
15 of the same for the first year, shall be Five
16 and the names of said Trustees are; James
17 H. Johnson, Guy G. Barton, Isaac Dillon,
18 Alexander H. Coomer and John Bailey.

19 5th The operations of said Company
20 shall be carried on in the town of Boise
21 City, in the County of Ada, and Territory
22 of Idaho, as its principal place of busi-
23 =ness; and in the locality where it shall
24 be engaged in the prosecution of its work,
25 and it may exercise its corporate powers
26 in the Territory of Idaho; it may also estab-
27 =lish Officers at such place or places, in
28 Idaho or elsewhere, as may be deemed ad-
29 =visable by the Board of Trustees.

30 6th The natural streams of water courses
31 from which the water is to be taken for
32 the purpose of being conveyed and applied

1 to the uses of this corporation and in
2 accordance with its corporate powers
3 as hereinbefore set forth is the Snake
4 River and its Tributaries also Boise River
5 and its Tributaries in Idaho Territory,
6 at such points on said streams and its
7 Tributaries as may be thought advisable
8 by the Board of Trustees and the said water
9 is to be used for the purposes of facilita-
10 -ting the business of this Corporation and
11 for all the uses hereinbefore set forth.

12 7th This Corporation in addition to the
13 corporate powers hereinbefore enumer-
14 -ated shall have power:

15 1st To have succession by its cor-
16 -porate name for the term of Fifty years
17 as limited in its certificate of charter.

18 2^d To sue and be sued, complain
19 and ^{defend} in any Court of Law or Equity.

20 3^d To make and use a common
21 seal and to alter the same at pleasure.

22 4th To hold, purchase and convey
23 such real and personal estate as the
24 purposes of the Corporation may require

25 5th To appoint such subordi-
26 -nate officers and agents as the busi-
27 -ness of the Corporation may require
28 and to allow them a suitable compen-
29 -sation.

30 6th To make by-laws not in-
31 -consistent with any existing laws,
32 for the management of its property, the

the regulation of its affairs and for the transfer of its stock.

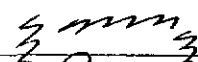
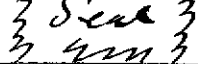

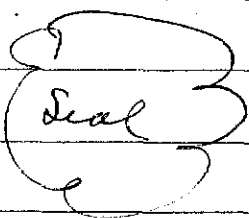
