## ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we, the undersigned, all bona fide residents of this State, do hereby associate ourselves together for the purpose of forming a nonprofit corporation according to and under the Laws of the State of Idaho, and we do hereby certify:

### I.

That the name of this Corporation is KAMIAH REBEKAHS, Lodge No. 50, Incorporated, Independent Order of Odd Fellows of Kamiah, Idaho.

### II.

That the purpose for which this Corporation is formed are to lease, purchase, receive, hold, sell, convey, and mortgage such real or personal property as such lodge or corporation may acquire, own, or use for the purposes of carrying out the social, charitable, benevolent, and other purposes of such corporation or lodge, according to the Constitution, Bylaws, Rules and Regulations of the Independent Order of Odd Fellows and the Laws of the State of Idaho. To borrow money, to be evidenced by promissory notes, bonds, or other lawful obligations, either secured or unsecured, by the hypothecation of any or all of its real, personal or mixed property, and to that end to enter into such lawful contracts as may be necessary to raise money to build or complete a building, to be occupied in whole or in part, as a hall to be used for the purposes of said lodge. To pay any debt existing against said lodge, before its incorporation, or any debt it may hereafter contract, in furtherance of the purpose for which it is incorporated, and the objects and purposes of said Order.

III.

That the place where its principal business is to be transacted is the City of Kamiah, County of Lewis, and State of Idaho.

The street address of the initial registered office of the corporation shall be 517 Main, Kamiah, Idaho 83536, and the initial registered agent shall be Veda Doty.

IV.

That the existence of this Corporation be perpetual.

V.

The number of its Directors shall be three (3).

VI.

This Corporation is a nonprofit membership corporation, and has no capital stock, and is not organized for pecuniary profit.

VII.

That on the 18 day of November, 1982, at the lodge room of Kamiah Rebekahs Lodge No. 50, I.O.O.F., in the City of Kamiah, County of Lewis, State of Idaho, an election was held for the purpose of electing Directors, at which time and place a majority of the members of said Lodge who were present voted, and said election resulted in the election of the following persons to serve as directors, towit:

Mrs. Phyllis Callies, of Kamiah, Idaho, Idaho, to serve as a Director until December 31, 1983.

Mrs. Pearl Stanbery, of Kamiah, Idaho, Idaho, to serve as a Director until December 31, 1984.

Mrs. Veda Doty, of Kamiah, Idaho, Idaho, to serve as a Director until December 31, 1985.

That prior to the date of said election, notice of the

time and place of holding such election was given by publication in the Clearwater Progress, a weekly newspaper published in Kamiah, Idaho, in the County in which such Corporation is located, for not less than two weeks immediately preceding the date for such election, and a like notice was posted in a conspicuous place on the building where the said election was held, for the same length of time.

VIII.

There shall be held annually a meeting of such Corporation, the particular date of which shall be fixed by its Bylaws, at which annual meeting there shall be elected one (1) Director, to serve for a term of three (3) years.

IX.

The names and addresses of each incorporator are set forth in Exhibit "A", which is attached hereto and incorporated by this reference.
