

Certificate of Articles of Incorporation
of The Idaho North and South Railway
Company. —

Know all men by these Presents: That
the whose names are subscribed hereto,
do hereby certify that under and by
virtue of the Laws of the Territory of Idaho
have associated ourselves together as a
railway corporation for the purposes of
constructing owning and operating a
rail road and extensions and branches
as hereinafter stated. —

I —

The name of said corporation by which it
shall be known and under which it
shall transact its business, shall continue
to be and shall be the Idaho North
and South Railway Company. —

II —

The object for which said company has been
and is formed is the construction, operating
and running a railroad or railroads
from a point commencing at or near
Maupia, a station on the Oregon Short
Line, one of the branches of the Union
Pacific Railway and in the County of
Ada, Territory of Idaho running from
thence in a North easterly direction through
the Counties of Ada and Boise, by way
of Star Post Office, Emmett, Horse Shoe
Bend on the Payette River. Thence

run in a North westerly direction, via
Long Valley, Big Rayette Lake,
Leviston, Spokane Falls and to some
point on Puget Sound to be hereafter de-
termined by said Railway Company,
and in a South westerly direction by way
of Sucker Creek, Jordan Valley, De
La Mar, South Mountain and on to
the Pacific Coast by the most eligible
route to be selected by the Company
to some point to be hereafter determined
by the Company.

— The said Company shall have power
to locate and construct and operate the
whole or any part of said road above des-
cribed and to transport passengers, mail
and freight thereon and to receive there-
for fare, toll and charges and generally
to transact all such business and to do
all such acts generally as may be nec-
essary to the success of the corporation.

— The said Company hereby formed
has power to mortgage its road, franchise
and property to secure such issue of bonds
as it may determine to execute, to build
such extensions and branches as it may
under any amendment of its charter
or Articles of Incorporation or otherwise un-
der lawful authority resolve to build ^{and}
to make running arrangements with
any other Railway or Transportation Com-
pany, or to lease purchase or otherwise

acquire the charter, road property or capital stock or franchises of any such Company, or to merge or amalgamate or consolidate into any such company on such terms as may be agreed upon by the Trustees or stock-holders not inconsistent with law, —

The said Company may construct such branches and connections in the said Territory of Idaho and in the States of Washington, Oregon, Nevada and California as it may deem expedient and necessary to consummate the purposes and objects of this charter and change and relocate its main line and branches as it may elect to connect with other railroads and Navigation companies and ^{way} amend its certificate of incorporation in such a way as the trustees or a majority of its stock holders may determine, not inconsistent ^{with} the statute in such cases made and provided.

— The said Company assumes to itself ^{and} shall and does possess all of the rights, powers, franchises, and privileges granted to and conferred upon corporations by the laws of Idaho Territory, and particularly by chapters 4 + 11 Little 4 concerning Corporations of the Revised Statutes of Idaho 1887 —

III

The amount of Capital stock of the said Company shall be three millions dollars or to such further amount as may be required

to construct complete and equip said road
or extensions or branches. _____

The stockholders are not indi-
vidually liable for the debts of the com-
pany nor liable to any extent beyond the
liability to pay for the stock by them sev-
erally subscribed _____

The said stock of said corporation shall con-
sist of shares of the par value of one hun-
dred dollars each. _____

The term of existence of said corporation
shall be fifty years from the first day of
January 1890. _____

The number of Trustees or Directors of said Cor-
poration who shall manage the concerns of
the same for the first year shall be five and
the names of said Trustees are: _____

VIII. —

The Trustees of said Corporation shall have power to make and adopt By-Laws for its government, not inconsistent with the laws of Congress and of this Territory for the management and disposition of the stock and business affairs of said Corporation and prescribing the duties of officers, Artificers and servants. That may be employed, for the appointment of all officers and for carrying on all kinds of business within the objects and purposes of said corporation
