Pirst:- The name of such corporation is THE WALLACE MANUFACTURING, ELECTRIC AND WATER COMPANY.

Second. The purpose for which said corporation is found is, to engage in general manufacturing, furnish to the Town of Wallace, in Shoshone County, Idaho Territory, and its citizens, electric light for illuminating purposes, in accordance with the usual methods adopted for such purpose, and obtain from said Town of Wallace the necessary franchise therefor; also, to furnish the said Town of Wallace and its citizens with water from streams in the vicinity thereof, for general purposes, through a proper system or systems of water works that may be necessary for such purpose, and to obtain from said Town of Wallace the necessary franchise therefor.
