RTICLES OF INCORPORATION - NONPROFIT CORPORATION

We, the sundersigned, being of legal age, do hereby associate ourselves of together for the purposes of forming a nonprofit corporation under the statutes of the State of Idaho.

ARTICLE ONE NAME

The name of the corporation is "LIGHT OF LEARNING ACADEMY, INC."

ARTICLE TWO ADDRESS

The post office address of the corporation's principle office is Route 7, Box 128, Idaho Falls, Idaho 83401. The name of its' initial registered agent at such address is Douglas M. Judy.

The above location of the corporation's principle office may be changed at any time by the board of directors without amendment to these Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE THREE TYPE OF CORPORATION

The corporation is a nonprofit corporation which shall have members.

ARTICLE FOUR DURATION

The period of duration of this nonprofit corporation shall be perpetual, unless dissolved and disincorporated as provided by law.

ARTICLE FIVE CORPORATE PURPOSE

This nonprofit corporation is organized for the following purposes: to establish, maintain, and operate recreational and educational institutions; to own, maintain, and operate land, facilities, equipment, etc. for use in connection with such institutions for the teaching and training of students in either the theoretical or practical aspects of any field of education; for the purpose of enjoyment and learning; and to disseminate knowledge in all areas including academic, physical, vocational, etc.

The corporation shall have the right to do and accomplish all things and engage in any other lawful transactions which a corporation organized under the Non-Profit Corporation Laws of Idaho might do, accomplish, or engage in, whether similar to the foregoing or otherwise.

The foregoing enumeration of specific purposes and objects shall not be held to limit or restrict in any manner the objects, purposes, or powers of the corporation, but shall be in furtherance of and in addition to and not in limitation of the general powers conferred by the Non-Profit Corporation Laws of Idaho, all of which powers this corporation shall have.

ARTICLE SIX NO PECUNIARY GAIN

This corporation is not organized for a pecuniary profit. It shall not have the power to issue certificates of stock or declare dividends, and no part of its net earnings shall inure to the benefit of any member, director, or individual. The corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay and receive reasonable compensation for services rendered, to make payments and distributions, to purchase supplies and equipment, etc. in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article Five above.

The corporation shall have the power to hold the real and personal property which may be acquired either by gifts, device, or otherwise, and may invest, use and manage the same in such a manner as to afford revenue to be applied to the proper uses of the corporation, and exchange or convey the same in accordance with the conditions of the same and the terms of these articles.

ARTICLE SEVEN LIMITATION OF MEMBER'S LIABILITY

The private property of the members of this corporation shall not be liable for its corporate debts.
