".

For four consecutive weeks prior to said meeting, Notice was published in the Spokane Valley Herald, Spokane County Washington, that a meeting was to be held on January 27, 1965, at 7:30 p.m. in the Millwood Community Presbyterain Church, Millwood, Washington, for the purpose of approving or disapproving a proposed change in the name of property located east of Post Falls, Kootenai County, Idaho, from *Post Falls Conference Grounds, Inc.
