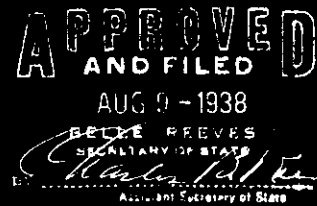

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
STANDARD X-RAY SALES CO.



HAROLD K. HOVLAND, C. E. BOUCHER and MERLE L. TEGARDEN,
each and all of whom are over twenty-one years of age and
citizens of the United States, do hereby associate themselves for
the purpose of forming a corporation under the uniform business
corporation act of the state of Washington, and for that purpose
do hereby adopt and certify, in triplicate, the following as
their Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I.

The name of the corporation shall be STANDARD X-RAY
SALES CO.

ARTICLE II.

Its purpose is:

First: To engage in and carry on the business of
acquiring, owning, using, buying, selling, leasing, exchanging,
designing, constructing, manufacturing, assembling, repairing,
distributing, marketing, or otherwise dealing in machinery,
appliances, electrical equipment, plants and factories, and
accessories and supplies therefor, of every nature, kind and
description whatsoever, and to equip, erect and install the
same for all uses and purposes; to act as agent or broker for
manufacturers and sellers of machinery, appliances, electrical
equipment, plants and factories, and accessories and supplies
therefor; and to buy, sell and deal in all kinds of commodities.

Second: To carry on the business of electrical and mechanical engineering; to produce and utilize in every manner and by every means electricity, motive power, and any like power which may be useful and convenient, x-ray, radium, light, including infra-red to ultra violet, sound, heat and any radiation in any capacity or form, for any and all uses and purposes; to establish, equip and operate a general industrial x-ray business for examination and consultation concerning all objects and articles in the industrial field; and to acquire, own, buy, sell, lease, hire, exchange, design, construct, manufacture, assemble, repair, market, establish, equip and install x-ray and electro-medical equipment, and accessories and supplies therefor.

Third: To apply for, or purchase or otherwise acquire, and to grant licences for the use of, to sell, assign or otherwise deal in and use patents, patent rights, licenses, copyrights, trademarks, trade-names, devices and improved or secret processes of every kind and description, necessary and incidental to these purposes.

Fourth: To acquire by purchase or otherwise, and to own, sell, lease and deal in real estate, bonds, stocks, and other securities, choses in action and properties of all kinds, and to borrow money and give security therefor.

Fifth: To acquire and take by lease, grant, purchase, donation, prescription or other lawful means, lands and tenements, goods, chattels and choses in action of every kind and description, embracing property, either real, personal or mixed, together with the increase or accession thereof, which any natural or artificial person may of right acquire or take, to hold the same title and in similar right and in like manner to use, operate, better, improve, encumber, deal in, dedicate, alienate the same in

whole or in part as any person, natural or artificial, may lawfully do.

Sixth: To enter into partnership or any other arrangement for sharing of profits, union of interests, cooperation, joint adventure, reciprocal concession or otherwise, with any person or company, carrying on or engaged in or about to carry on, or engage in any business or transaction which the company is authorized to carry on, or engage in any business or transaction, capable of being conducted so as to directly or indirectly benefit the company, and to lend money to, guarantee the contract of, or otherwise acquire shares and securities in any such company, and to sell, hold, re-issue, with or without guarantee, or otherwise deal with the same.

Seventh: To enter into contracts or arrangements with any government or authority, national, state, municipal, local or otherwise, conducive to any of the purposes of this corporation, and to obtain from government or authority any and all rights, easements, privileges, subsidies, gifts, franchises, charters, grants, patents or concessions, relating to or for the promotion or protection of such purpose.

Eighth: To do each and everything necessary, suitable, useful or convenient for the accomplishment of any one or more of the objects herein set forth. To exercise any and all powers, which may now or hereafter be lawful for the corporation to do or exercise under or in pursuance to the laws of the state of Washington, the enumeration of specific powers not being intended, nor shall it be construed to limit or in any manner restrict such general powers.

ARTICLE III.

The corporate existence shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE IV.

The location and post office address of the registered office of the corporation in this state shall be 1615 Second Avenue, Seattle, Washington.

ARTICLE V.

The capital stock of the corporation shall be Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000.00) divided into Two Hundred (200) shares of the par value of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) per share. Each share shall be entitled to one vote at shareholders' meetings, and the rights and duties of shareholders shall be identical.

ARTICLE VI.

The corporation shall begin business with a paid in capital stock of Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$15,000.00) in cash and other property taken in at a fair valuation.

ARTICLE VII.

The first directors, their names and post office addresses are:

These directors shall serve until the first meeting of the shareholders and until their successors are elected and qualified. The first meeting of the shareholders shall be at the registered office of the corporation in Seattle, Washington, on the first Monday in March, 1939.
