

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION  
OF  
TOMLINSON LUMBER MILLS, INC.

We, the undersigned, all of lawful age, do associate ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under the Minnesota Business Corporation Act, and do make, subscribe and acknowledge these Articles of Incorporation to-wit:

1. The name of this corporation is:

Tomlinson Lumber Mills, Inc.

2. Its purposes

To carry on business as sawmill proprietors, lumber merchants, and dealers in building materials of all kinds; to manufacture, purchase, sell, and deal in lumber or wood products, steel, cement, plastics, paints, hardware and generally to lease, buy, sell, use, mortgage, improve and otherwise handle, deal in, and dispose of all such property, real and personal, as may be necessary or convenient in connection with the aforesaid business of the company.

To purchase or otherwise acquire, and to hold and own, or to sell, assign, transfer, mortgage, pledge, or otherwise dispose of, stock, bonds, or other obligations of any corporation formed for, or then or thereafter engaged in, or purchasing any one or more of the kinds of business above mentioned, or owning or holding any property which the company might lawfully own or hold, and generally to enter into obligations or contracts and do any acts incidental to the transaction of its business or expedient for the attainment of the purpose herein stated.

3. Its duration shall be perpetual.

4. The location and postoffice address of its registered office in this state is Hoffman, Grant County, Minnesota.

5. The total authorized number of its shares is one thousand (1,000), each of the par value of one hundred dollars (\$100.00), such shares to be of one class only, known as Common Stock, each share being entitled to one vote.
