I, ARNOLD WILLIAMS, Secretary of State of the State of Idaho, and legal custodian of the corporation records of the State of Idaho, do hereby certify that the original of the articles of incorporation of

THE LATAH COUNTY PIONEER ASSOCIATION, INC.

was filed in the office of the Secretary of State on the **Twentieth** day of **October**, A. D. One Thousand Nine Hundred **Sixty-one** and is duly recorded on Film No. 114 of Record of Domestic Corporations, of the State of Idaho, and that the said articles contain the statement of facts required by Section 30-103 and Sections 30-1001 to 30-1005, inclusive, Idaho Code.

I FURTHER CERTIFY, That the persons executing the articles and their associates and successors are hereby constituted a corporation, by the name hereinbefore stated, for

perpetual existence from the date hereof, with its registered office in this State located at

Moscow in the County of Latak

and as such are subject to the rights, privileges and limitations granted to Non-Profit Cooperative Associations as provided in Chapter 10, Title 30, Idaho Code.

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

THE LATAH COUNTY PIONEER ASSOCIATION, INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That We, the undersigned, being natural persons of full age and citizens of the United States, in order to form a non-profit cooperative association for the purposes hereinafter stated, under and pursuant to Title 30, Chapter 10 of the Idaho Code and acts amendatory thereof and supplemental thereto, do hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation for such association:

ONE

The name of the proposed association is and shall be: THE LATAH COUNTY PIONEER ASSOCIATION, INC.

T W O

The location and post office address and the principal office for the transaction of business of this association is: COUNTY COURTHOUSE, MOSCOW, LATAH COUNTY, IDAHO, MUSEUM

THREE

The Association is to have perpetual existence.

F O U R

The purposes and objects for which this Corporation is formed are:

- (A) To discover, procure and maintain whatever may relate to the history of Latah County, Idaho.
 - (B) To build and maintain museums.
- (C) To commission and publish literary, pictorial and artistic matter pertaining to the history of Latah County, Idaho, and its residents.
- (D) To promote and foster public interest in the history of Latah County, Idaho.
- (E) To acquire, sell and otherwise exercise the incidents of ownership with respect to such real and personal property as may be reasonably necessary for the purposes and objects of this society.

F I V E

To do anything necessary to accomplish the objects and purposes of the association except as limited by this instrument and the laws of the State of Idaho.

S I X

This association shall not engage in any business, trade, avocation or profession for gain or profit; provided that it may sell souvenirs and use the profits thereof in the accomplishment of its purposes and objects.

SEVEN

- (A) The members of this association shall not be subject to assessments, other than membership dues as hereinafter provided.
- (B) This association shall not borrow money or become otherwise indebted except upon the approval of a majority of the members of the Board of Directors.

EIGHT

The conditions and regulations of membership and the rights or other priviliges of the classes of members shall be determined and fixed by the bylaws, provided that the rights and interests of all members shall be equal; and no member can have or acquire a greater interest therein than any other member; the dues to be paid by each member and the procedure for terminating membership shall likewise be fixed by the bylaws.

NINE

The number of directors of this association shall be not less than three nor more than seven. The members may, from time to time, as provided in the bylaws, within the limits set forth above, prescribed the number of directors. The directors shall hold office until the next annual meeting of the members, and until their successors are duly elected and qualified.

T E N

In the event of a dissolution of this association the disposition of the assets or property shall be determined at the time of such dissolution by the Board of Directors, pro-

vided that such assets or property may be transferred only
to a non-profit corporation or agency of government having
objects and purposes similar to those to which this association
is devoted; provided further that in no event shall any of the
assets or property of this association or the proceeds of any
of said assets or property, in the event of dissolution thereof,
go or be distributed to members, either for the reimbursement
of any sum subscribed, donated or contributed by such members,
or for any other such purpose, it being the intent that in the
dissolution of this association, or upon its ceasing to carry
out the objects and purposes herein set forth, the property
and assets then owned by the association shall be devoted to
the carrying on of the function and purposes of a non-profit
historical society as the Board of Directors shall determine
and direct.

ELEVEN

These Articles of Incorporation may be amended after approval by the Board of Directors by a simple majority vote of the voting members of the association at a special meeting called for the purpose; or at a regular meeting upon notice of the intention to consider such amendment.
