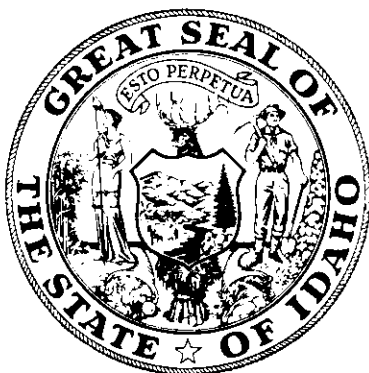

5. Notice as required by Section 30-1-87 was complied with.


6. All debts, obligations and liabilities of the corporation have been paid.






