ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

PRIVATE CONTRACTORS ASSOCIATION OF IDAHO, INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That we, the undersigned, being natural persons of full age and citizens of the United States of America, in order to form a corporation for the purposes hereinafter stated, pursuant to the corporation laws of the State of Idaho, do hereby certify as follows:

I

The name of this corporation is PRIVATE CONTRACTORS ASSOCIATION OF IDAHO, INC.

II

The purposes for which this corporation is formed are:

To promote, carry on, conduct and foster the construction industry in the State of Idaho, particularly in reference to the role taken by private contractors in said construction industry, in respect to the construction, alteration, repair, addition to, improvement, wrecking, or demolition of any structure, building, highway, road, excavation, project, development, or improvement, or any part thereof, including the erection of scaffolding or other structure or works in connection therewith or a unit or segment thereof; to consider and resolve problems of this particular type of construction industry and its various segments; to promote and develop a program for the marketing of its products and/or the dissemination of its services and to provide and furnish information and data to such private contractors engaged in such construction and other activities hereinbefore enumerated relating thereto, all for the advancement of the marketing of its products and the dissemination of its various services; to study, engage in, assist and support

legislation favorable to said type of construction industry and to conduct, engage in, support and promote educational and research programs in said industry; and to foster the improvement of any laws applicable to private contractors and which regulate their activities in any manner whatsoever.

The association is authorized to take and hold by bequest, devise, gift, purchase or lease, either absolutely or in trust for any of its purposes, any property, real or personal, without limitation as to amount or value; to transfer and convey the same and to invest and re-invest the principal and income thereof and to deal with and expend the principal and income of the corporation in such manner as in the judgment of the directors will best promote its objects; and in order properly to prosecute the objects and purposes as above set forth, the corporation shall have full power and authority to purchase, lease and otherwise acquire, hold, mortgage, convey and otherwise dispose of all kinds of property, both real and personal, and generally to perform all acts which may be deemed necessary for the proper and successful prosecution of the objects and purposes for which it is created. /

This corporation is formed under the provisions of and pursuant to Title 30, Chapter 10, Idaho Code, non-profit cooperative associations, and is not organized and is not to be conducted for the purpose directly or indirectly, of fixing the price, or regulating the production of any article of commerce or of products of the soil or of consumption by the people.

### III

The period of existence and duration of the life of this corporation shall be perpetual.

### IV

The location and post office address of the registered office of this corporation in the State of Idaho shall be Boise, in the County of Ada, State of Idaho.

Section 1. This corporation is organized and shall function without capital stock.

The voting power of this corporation shall repose in its members and shall be equal in that each member shall have one vote only. Voting by proxy and voting by mail shall be permitted in such instances and in the manner as provided by the By-Laws of this corporation.

Membership may be terminated or cancelled at such time and in accordance with the procedure fixed and established by the By-Laws of this corporation.

Section 2. This corporation is not organized for profit and no part of its earnings shall inure to the benefit of any member or any individual.

No member, director, officer or employee of this corporation shall receive or be lawfully entitled to receive any profit of any kind from the operation thereof excepting only reasonable compensation for services actually rendered for the corporation in effecting one or more of its purposes.

In the event of dissolution or liquidation of this corporation, all of its property shall be transferred and paid over to the IDAHO ELKS REHABILITATION CENTER at Boise, Idaho, for the general purposes for which said organization was formed and is conducted.

## VI

The authority is hereby conferred upon the members of this corporation to repeal or amend the By-Laws or adopt new By-Laws of this corporation.
