I, PETE T. CHARRUSA, Secretary of State of the State of Idaho, and legal custodian of the corporation records of the State of Idaho, do hereby certify that the original of the articles of incorporation of

SNAKE RIVER RACING ASSOCIATION, INCORPORATED

was filed in the office of the Secretary of State on the **ninth** day of

December A. D. One Thousand Nine Hundred **seventy** and
is duly recorded on ~~film No. microfilm~~ Record of Domestic Corporations of the State of Idaho,
and that the said articles contain the statement of facts required by Sections 30-103, 30-1101
and 30-1102, Idaho Code.

AND I FURTHER CERTIFY, That the persons executing the articles and their associates
and successors are hereby constituted a corporation, by the name stated in the articles, and for

fifty years from the date hereof, with its registered office in this State located
at **Bliss, Idaho** in the County of **Gooding**
and as such are subject to the rights, privileges and limitations granted to Religious, Ex-Service
Men, Benevolent, Charitable and Fraternal Corporations, as provided in Chapter 11, Title 30,
Idaho Code.

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
SNAKE RIVER RACING ASSOCIATION, INCORPORATED

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we, the undersigned, all of whom are bona fide residents of the State of Idaho, have this day voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a non-profit association or corporation under the provisions of Chapter II of Title 30, Idaho Code.

AND WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY:

I.

That the name of said non-profit corporation shall be:

"Snake River Racing Association, Incorporated."

II.

That the purposes for which the said non-profit corporation is formed are.

A. To develop and promote chariot racing, good sportsmanship and all phases and matters or things pertaining to chariot racing, horses and horsemanship among those who are interested in or have a love for horses and chariot racing.

B. To assist in developing and improving the breeding, quality and quality of running horses and chariot horses in and about the Snake River area.

C. To own, build, develop, hold and manage all kinds and character of property and buildings for the care, maintenance, and upkeep, riding, exercising and showing of horses.

D. To own, build, construct, operate and manage club houses and other buildings in order to provide a common meeting place for those who are interested in chariot races, horses and horsemanship and for all activities in any way related to or required by the other aims and objects of this association.

E. To manage, control, operate and supervise any and all kinds of chariot races, shows, horse races, rodeos, horse sales, or any or all other activities in any way related to or

connected with chariot racing, horses and horsemanship, including the right to put on, operate and manage any and all kinds of chariot races, flat races, shows, exhibitions, fairs or any other kind or form of amusement that may be decided upon, either in connection with chariot races, horses and horsemanship or in order to raise funds and money to carry out the other objects and purposes of this association.

III.

The said corporation shall have each and all of the every powers given to such corporation by the statutes of the State of Idaho as now existing or as hereafter amended and including (without limiting the generality of the foregoing) the right to take, receive, hold, convey, lease or mortgage real and personal property of every kind and character in any way required for or related to the purposes and objects of this corporation, and the right to, through its proper officers and directors, borrow money for any purposes or objects whatsoever in any way connected with, related to, required for or necessary for the carrying out of the purposes and objects of this corporation, and to make, issue and deliver in return for any monies borrowed any form of note, debenture, bond, certificate, or other evidence of indebtedness that the directors and officers may from time to time decide upon to evidence and secure monies borrowed and to secure the payment of any such evidence of indebtedness that may be issued by mortgages covering both the real and personal property of the corporation or by pledge of the income for any activities indulged in by the corporation.

IV.

The original members of this corporation shall be all those persons who were bona fide members in good standing of the Snake River Racing Association, Incorporated on the 14th day of November, 1970, and such other persons who may be in the future admitted to membership in the association in accordance with the constitution and by-laws of this association, it being specifically provided that the said corporation may provide for the admission of such future members in the manner and method and under the authority of Section 30-1108 Idaho Code. Membership in the corporation shall be evidenced by certificates of membership, which certificates shall be non-

transferrable, and subject to revocation or termination as provided in the constitution or by-laws of the said corporation.

V.

The principal office and the place where the principal business of this corporation is to be transacted is the Village of Bliss, County of Gooding, State of Idaho.

VI.

That the term for which this corporation is to exist is fifty (50) years.

VII.

That the said corporation shall be managed by a board of seven directors, which board shall have charge and management of the real estate and personal property of the corporation and the promotion, operation and management of said corporation. That its officers shall be a president, vice-president, secretary-treasurer, who shall be elected or appointed as provided in the constitution or by-laws of the association.

VIII.

That in accordance with the provisions of Section 30-1102 Idaho Code, an election was held on the 14th day of November, 1970, for the purpose of electing the directors of the board under which said corporation elects to operate, being as heretofore stated seven in number; said election being held at Wood Cafe in Jerome, Idaho; that a notice of the time and place of holding of said election of directors was given by the publication of a notice to said effect two weeks in advance of said meeting (i.e., by three notices with one week elapsing between the first and second and second and third notices) in the Gooding Leader, a newspaper published in said City of Gooding, Idaho; that at such meeting a majority of the members present voted for and there was elected as directors of said corporation, the following persons, to-wit:

The immediate past president shall be ex-officio member of the Board of Directors as its seventh member.

IX.

That this is a non-profit corporation and shall not have capital stock.

X.

That this corporation shall have the right to adopt a constitution and by-laws in accordance with the provisions of Section 29-1108 Idaho Code.
