a corporation organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Idaho, filed in this office on the 26th day of January 1960, original articles of amendment, as provided by Sections 30-145, 30-147 and 30-160, Idaho Code, changing corporate name to UNITED PRESEYTERIAN CHURCH OF EMMETT, and extending term of existence to perpetuity.

"Be it hereby resolved that the name of the corporation of the FIRST PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH OF EMMETT be amended by striking out the word "FIRST" and substituting the word "UNITED", so that the new name of the corporation shall read: UNITED PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH OF EMMETT.

And be it further resolved that the existence of the corporation shall be made perpetual, and that these amendments be registered with the Secretary of the State of Idaho in Boise."
