ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

of

C A R E N C O    I N C O R P O R A T E D

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that we, the undersigned, have this day voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Idaho.

WE HEREBY CERTIFY:

FIRST: That the name of this corporation is CARENCO INCORPORATED.

SECOND: That the objects and purposes for which this corporation is organized are as follows:

1. To carry on, in all branches thereof, the business usually carried on by an equipment leasing agency; to rent or lease, motor vehicles, accessories or other items of equipment, furniture, machines and personal property which can reasonably be made the subject of lease agreements for use by persons, firms, corporations, partnerships or business agencies, and to buy, sell or trade and deal generally in motor vehicles, accessories, office furniture, machines and personal property, to the accomplishment of conducting such an equipment leasing agency."
2. To conduct said businesses above specified in all their branches and ramifications, and to have and maintain one or more offices, places of business, or warehouses for the transaction of its business, and hold without limit, purchase and convey, real and personal property, both within and without the State of Idaho, that is to say, in the State of Idaho, and in all other states and places.
3. To purchase, or otherwise acquire, own, sell, assign or otherwise transfer and convey, trade, deal in or with, goods, wares, merchandise and property of every class, variety and description.
4. To hold, purchase, or otherwise acquire, to sell, assign, transfer, mortgage, pledge, or otherwise dispose of, shares of the capital stock, bonds, or other evidence of indebtedness created by any other corporation, or corporations, and while the holder of such stock, to exercise all the rights and privileges of ownership, including the right to vote thereon, to the same extent as a natural person might do or could do.
5. To make, enter into and execute contracts of every kind and character with individuals, firms, associations and corporations, private, public and municipal, and bodies politic, and with the government of the United States, and of any state or

territory, colony or district thereof.

6. This corporation shall have power to borrow or raise money without limit as to amount by the issue of or upon warrants, bonds, debentures, and other negotiable or transferable instruments, or other obligations of the corporation, and to secure the payment of any such obligations by mortgage, pledge, deed, indenture, agreement or other instrument of trust, or by other lien upon, assignment of, or agreement in regard to all or any part of the property of the corporation wherever situated, whether now owned or hereafter acquired.

7. To do each and every thing necessary, suitable, or proper for the accomplishment of any of the purposes, or the attainment of any one or more of the objects herein enumerated, or which at any time appear conducive to or expedient for the protection or benefit of this corporation.

THIRD: That the term for which this corporation is to exist is perpetual.

FOURTH: That the location and Post Office address of the registered office of this corporation shall be 201 The People's Store Building, West Center Street, Post Office Box 429, Pocatello, Idaho.

FIFTH: That the amount of capital stock of this corporation shall be Ten Thousand (\$10,000.00) Dollars, to consist of One Hundred (100) shares of common stock of the par value of \$100 each.
