TOTAL TEXT OF ARTICLE 8

In the event of the dissolution or winding up of this chapter, voluntarily or otherwise, all of its assets remaining after payment, or provision for the payment, of all debts and liabilities of the chapter shall be distributed to the **Evergreen District Association of Chapters of SPEBSQSA** ("District") if it is then existing and organized and operated exclusively for charitable and/or educational purposes and exempt from taxation under Section501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. If the District is not then existing and so organized, operating and exempt, then such remaining assets shall be distributed to the Society for the Preservation and Encouragement of Barber Shop Quartet Singing in America, Incorporated (the "Society") if it is then existing and so organized, operating and exempt; but if neither the Districtor the Society is then existing and so organized, operating and exempt, then such remaining assets shall distributed to another existing organization that is organized and operating exclusively for one or more of the purposes for which the District and the Society were formed, and which is exempt from taxation under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. [Canadian chapters shall make distribution of such property to one or more registered Canadian charitable organizations.] The corporation's activities shall be conducted without personal gain for its individual members and any profits or other inurements to the corporation shall be used in promoting the purposes of the Society, its districts or chapters.
