

We, the undersigned, being respectively, the President and Cashier of THE DESERET SAVINGS BANK, a corporation duly organized and existing by virtue of the laws of the State of Utah, do hereby certify that at a special meeting of the Stockholders of said corporation, held at the principal office of said company in the city of Salt Lake, in said State of Utah, on the sixth day of April, . . . 1918, pursuant to notice given in the following manner, to-wit, by mailing to each of the stockholders of said corporation, at least ten days prior to said sixth day of April, . . . 1918 and a written notice in sealed envelope properly addressed and postage prepaid, stating the object of said meeting and the nature of said amendment to the Articles of Incorporation of said company and the time and place, when and where said meeting would be held, and also by general notice of the object of said meeting and the nature of said amendment to the said Articles and the time and place when and where said meeting would be held, published in the Deseret Evening News, a daily newspaper printed in the English language and having a general circulation in Salt Lake County, where said corporation has its general business in this state, said notice being first published in its issue of March 14th, 1918 and the last notice in its issue of April 5th, 1918.

The following resolution was duly submitted to the stockholders of said company at said meeting, and was duly adopted by a unanimous vote of all the stock represented at said meeting:

RESOLVED, that Article Five (5) of the Articles of Incorporation of the Deseret Savings Bank be amended so as to make said Article read as follows:
The amount of capital stock of this corporation shall be five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000.00) and shall be divided into five thousand (5,000) shares of the par value of one hundred Dollars (\$100.00) each.

That at said meeting there was represented a total of seven hundred and eighty seven (787) shares out of the total outstanding issue of one thousand (1,000) shares.

I, the President, and Miss A. the Cashier of The Deseret Savings Bank, a corporation of the State of Utah, being duly sworn depose and say: That at a stockholders meeting of The Deseret Savings Bank, a corporation of the State of Utah, duly called, and held on April 5th 1911, it was moved and carried that the capital stock of said corporation be increased from One Hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000.00) to Five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000.00); and that two-thirds of the capital stock of said corporation remain to be paid in cash. That at a meeting of the directors of said The Deseret Savings Bank, held on April 12th 1911, a check for One hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000.00) was duly delivered, to pay the full said increase of said capital stock; and I do hereby certify that the full amount of the increase of said capital stock has been fully paid.
