ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

of

NEZ PERCE COUNTY WHEAT GROWERS ASSOCIATION, INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That we, OTTO BRAMMER, GEORGE J. DAU, CHARLES GABBY, THOR GILJE, G. A. MISNER, HUGH PARKS, DARWIN W. TARRY, B. H. WITTMAN and D. LLOYD WYATT, all of whom are citizens of the United States of America and residents of the State of Idaho, do hereby associate ourselves together for the purpose of forming a non-profit cooperative association under provisions of Chapter 10 of Title 30, Idaho Code, and we do hereby adopt the following articles of incorporation viz:

ARTICLE I.

The name of this corporation shall be

NEZ PERCE COUNTY WHEAT GROWERS ASSOCIATION, INC.

ARTICLE II.

Pecuniary profit is not the object or purpose of the organization of this corporation.

The objects and purposes for which this corporation is formed are:

To promote and encourage —

The interests and welfare of the wheat producers and growers in the State of Idaho and particularly in the Nez Perce County area;

The advancement of the science of wheat growing and production;

The development of new uses for wheat and wheat by-products;

The development of improved strains of wheat;

The development of markets for wheat and by-products thereof;

Good farming and good farm marketing practices; and

The conservation of the natural resources of the State of Idaho and particularly in Nez Perce County.

To initiate and carry out economic and scientific programs

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The conservation of the natural resources of the State of Idaho and particularly in Nez Perce County.

To initiate and carry out economic and scientific programs

designed to achieve the purposes for which this corporation is formed as hereinabove set forth and to cooperate with other individuals, groups or organizations by furnishing information, financial assistance, use of facilities or otherwise, in developing or carrying out such programs.

To provide a central means of contact with any other agencies or groups, including agencies of local, state and federal government.

To inculcate and to promote a spirit of harmony among its members in achieving their common interest and to promote a spirit of public service and public responsibility throughout the agricultural industry.

To acquire by purchase, gift, devise or otherwise and to own, hold, mortgage or otherwise encumber, lease, sell, assign, exchange, transfer or in any other manner dispose of property, real, personal or mixed, within or without the State of Idaho.

To enter into, make and perform contracts of every kind for any lawful purpose, but not for profit or gain, financial or otherwise, with any person, firm, association or corporation, town, city, county, body politic, state, territory, government, or colony or dependency thereof.

The objects and purposes as specified herein should be regarded as independent objects and purposes, and, except where otherwise expressed, shall be in no way limited nor restricted by reference to or inference from the terms of any clause or paragraph of these Articles of Incorporation.

The foregoing shall be construed both as objects and powers, and the enumeration thereof shall not be held to limit or restrict in any manner the general powers conferred upon this corporation by the laws of the State of Idaho.

ARTICLE III.

The place where the principal office of this corporation shall be maintained, its principal place of business and the location and post office address of its registered office in this state shall be at Lewiston, Idaho.

ARTICLE IV.

The number of directors of this corporation shall be not less than nine

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as shall be fixed by the by-laws of this corporation, and the number of directors may be increased at any time by vote of the members in accordance with the by-laws of the corporation; the nine incorporators of this association shall act as and constitute the Board of Directors of said corporation until the first meeting of members and the regular election of directors of said corporation.

ARTICLE V.

This corporation shall have perpetual existence.

ARTICLE VI.

This corporation is organized without capital stock; the rights and interests of all members shall be equal and no member may acquire or have a greater interest therein than any other member; membership in the corporation may be acquired in such manner and upon such terms and conditions as shall be prescribed by the by-laws, and membership certificates shall be issued to each member of the corporation upon payment of the membership fee and compliance with the other qualifications and conditions of obtaining membership; the membership fee shall be in an amount to be fixed by the by-laws; membership certificates shall not be transferable except by resolution of the Board of Directors and under such regulations as the by-laws may prescribe.

ARTICLE VII.

That each of the incorporators hereof has actually subscribed for membership in this association.




