SKYVIEW

(Articles of Incorporation)

Approved by membership May 14, 2003 Electronically updated June 8, 2004

ARTICLE I: NAME

The name of this organization shall be the Canyon Owyhee Library Group, Ltd. (COLG).

ARTICLE II: PURPOSE

The purpose of this Organization shall be to advance the common library interest; to promote the organization and development of better library service in the Canyon Owyhee region; and to foster a cooperative librarian network through the sharing of ideas, resources, and materials.

"This corporation is organized exclusively for education purposes within the meaning of section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code."

"Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from Federal income tax under sections 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law) or (b) by a corporation contributions to which are deductible under section 170 (c) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or corresponding provision of any corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law)."

ARTICLE VI: TAX EXEMPT STATUS

"Upon the dissolution of this corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501 @ (3) of the Internal Revenue Code (or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the Federal government, or to a state or local government for public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed by the Court of Common Pleas of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

ARTICLE VIII: AM ENDMENTS

Section 1. This constitution and accompanying bylaws may be amended by a two-thirds majority of members woting during any business meeting of the organization in which a quorum is physically present .. by a quorum obtained via electronic polling.

Section 2. Amendments to the constitution or bylaws shall be submitted in written form by mail or electronic by email all members eligible to vote before the meeting at which amendments are to be voted upon or before the amendments are voted upon electronically.
