CERTIFICATE OF INCORPORATION

I, ARNOLD WILLIAMS, Secretary of State of the State of Idaho, and legal custodian of the corporation records of the State of Idaho, do hereby certify that the original of the articles of incorporation of

STATELINE GRANGE NO. 999, INC.

was filed in the office of the Secretary of State on the **Eighth** day of **June**, A. D. One Thousand Nine Hundred **Sixty**, and is duly recorded on Film No. **111** of Record of Domestic Corporations, of the State of Idaho, and that the said articles contain the statement of facts required by Section 30-103 and Sections 30-1001 to 30-1005, inclusive, Idaho Code.

I FURTHER CERTIFY, That the persons executing the articles and their associates and successors are hereby constituted a corporation, by the name hereinbefore stated, for **perpetual existence** from the date hereof, with its registered office in this State located at **Hamada,** in the County of **Owyhee,** and as such are subject to the rights, privileges and limitations granted to Non-Profit Cooperative Associations as provided in Chapter 10, Title 30, Idaho Code.

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

STATELINE GRANGE No. 399, INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that we, the undersigned, all being natural persons of full age and citizens of the United States, in order to form a cooperative association for the purposes hereinafter stated under and pursuant to the provisions of the corporation laws of the State of Idaho and acts amendary thereof and supplementary thereto, do hereby certify as follows:

FIRST: The name of this corporation is "STATELINE GRANGE No. 399, INC."

SECOND: The purposes specified herein shall be construed both as purposes and powers and shall be in no wise limited or restricted by reference to, or inference from, the terms of any other clause in this or any other article, but the purposes and powers specified in each of the clauses herein shall be regarded as independent purposes and powers, and the enumeration of specific purposes and powers shall not be construed to limit or restrict in any manner the meaning of general terms or of the general powers of the cooperative association; or shall the expression of one thing be deemed to exclude another, although it be of like nature not expressed. The purposes and objects for which this cooperative association is formed are as follows:

a. To organize a farmer's fraternal organization and to promote the economical and social betterment of the members thereof.

b. To establish, operate and maintain a grange hall for such purposes.

c. To solicit, collect and otherwise raise money or other property and to operate and maintain benefits and entertainment for the purposes of raising funds or other property for further-

ing the purposes herein specified.

d. To receive, build, purchase or otherwise acquire, hold, own, lease, mortgage, pledge, sell, exchange, give or otherwise dispose of, distribute or otherwise deal in and with personal property, goods, wares, merchandise of every kind and description.

e. To purchase, lease, receive, or otherwise acquire, hold, own, occupy, operate, manage, improve, develop, lease or otherwise use, mortgage, or otherwise encumber, sell, convey, give, or otherwise dispose of and deal in real property including its appurtenances and each and every right, interest and estate therein.

f. To make, perform and carry out contracts of every kind and description for any lawful purpose and for any amount with any person, firm, association or corporation, either public or private, or with any county, state or government or any agency thereof.

g. To borrow money and secure credit and to draw, make, accept, endorse, guarantee, execute and issue bonds, promissory notes and other evidences of indebtedness and for the purpose of securing the cooperative association's obligations or contracts, to convey, transfer, assign, endorse, deliver, mortgage or pledge all and any part of the cooperative association's assets upon such terms and conditions as the Board of Directors shall authorize and as may be permitted by law.

h. To employ agents and employees or persons, firms, associations or corporations in any other capacity for carrying on any purposes and objects of this cooperative association.

THIRD: This cooperative association is to have perpetual existence.

FOURTH: The location and post office address of the registered office of this corporation is Homedale, Owyhee County, Idaho.

FIFTH: This cooperative association is not organized for pecuniary profit and no dividend or other pecuniary profits shall be

declared to the membership hereof.

SIXTH: The rights, and interests of all members of this cooperative association shall be equal and no member shall have or acquire a greater interest in this cooperative association than any other member. This cooperative association shall not issue any capital stock but shall issue membership certificates to each member, which certificates cannot be assigned so that the transferee thereof can by such transfer become a member of this cooperative association.

SEVENTH: The membership of this cooperative association shall consist of all persons who are willing to subscribe to the objects of this cooperative association subject to such further requirements as may be established by the by-laws.

EIGHTH: The names and post office addresses of each of the incorporators of this cooperative association, all of whom have subscribed to the membership of this cooperative association, are as follows:

NINTH: The private property of the members shall not be subject to the payment of the debts of this cooperative association to any extent whatsoever, and the memberships of this cooperative association shall not be subject to assessments for the purposes of paying expenses, conducting business or paying debts of this cooperative association, other than such dues as may be fixed by the by-laws.

TENTH: The number of directors of this cooperative association shall be as specified by the by-laws and such number may be

increased or decreased in such manner as may be provided in the by-laws but the number of directors shall be not less than three.


