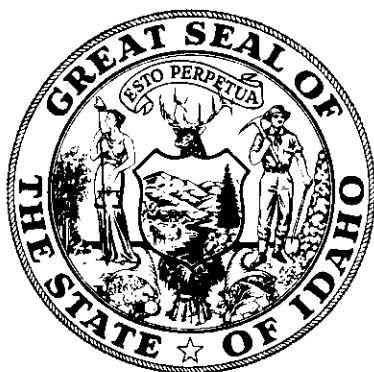

ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT  
of  
CHILD RESOURCES CENTER, INC.

Pursuant to I.C. Section 30-327, the undersigned non-profit corporation adopts the following amendment to its Articles of Incorporation filed August 13, 1981. There being no members, said amendment was adopted at a meeting of the Board of Directors held on November 9, 1983, receiving the vote of a majority of the directors in office: an addition to the original Articles of Incorporation is hereby added as follows:

VIII.  
DISTRIBUTION OF ASSETS UPON DISSOLUTION

Upon dissolution of the corporation, the Board of Directors shall, after paying or making provision for the payment of all of the liabilities of the corporation, dispose of all the assets of the corporation exclusively for the purposes of the corporation in such manner, or to such organization or organizations organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educational, religious, or scientific purposes as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law), as the Board of Directors shall determine. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the District Court of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as such court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
