ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
DECKER DOMESTIC WATER CO.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we, the undersigned, being full age citizens of the United States of America, have voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under Chapter 8, Title 30, of Idaho Code, which Chapter is entitled "Water and Canal Corporations and Waterusers Association", and under the provisions and conformity to the laws of the United States of America, pursuant to the Reclamation Act of the 17th day of June, 1902, and we do hereby set forth and declare as follows:

I.

That the name of this corporation is and shall be "DECKER DOMESTIC WATER CO."

II.

That the purposes for which said corporation is formed are:

- a. To conduct and carry on the business of supplying domestic and irrigation water to the stockholders of this corporation;
- b. To engage in laying pipes and conducting such water to consumers;
- c. To build and maintain ditches, canals, pipes and aqueducts, together with the necessary pumps, siphons and appliances for the conducting of said water;
- d. To buy, lease or exchange real or personal property, including easements, such as may be necessary in supplying the water to the stockholders of this corporation;
- e. To acquire machinery, fixtures, appliances, trucks and other materials and property as this corporation may deem necessary to carry into effect and to perpetuate the purposes for which said corporation was organized and exists;
- f. To sell, convey, lease, assign, mortgage or otherwise encumber or dispose of any and all real or personal property, and to do and perform all such acts and things as may be required and necessary in the premises of engaging in the general business as hereinbefore set out by and through these Articles of Incorporation, and in accordance with the laws of the State of Idaho; and
- g. To engage in and conduct any legal business not for pecuniary gain or profit to the members hereof.

III.

That the term for which said corporation is to exist is to be

1 perpetual.

3 That the principal place and office for the transaction of the
4 business of this corporation is located at Payette, Idaho.

14 That the amount of capital stock of this corporation shall be
15 24 shares in the amount of \$125.00 per share, making a total aggregate
16 capital of said corporation of \$3,000.00.

18 That there shall be only one class of shares issued by said
19 corporation, and the holders of such shares shall be entitled to
20 one vote per share.

21 VIII.

22 That the amount of capital stock which has been subscribed
23 is as follows:

29 IX.

30 That at the first meeting of the stockholders there shall be
31 five (5) directors elected; two of said directors to be elected for
32 a oneyear term, two of said directors to be elected for a two year
term and one of said directors to be elected for a three year term; and
that thereafter new directors will be elected to fill the expired
terms of the directors, but such terms of directors elected shall
be for three years.

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X.

That this corporation can furnish water only to its registered paid up stockholders.


XI.




