

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that we, the undersigned, have this day voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a Corporation, under the laws of the State of Idaho.

AND WE HEREBY CERTIFY:

First.. That the name of said Corporation is THE FARMERS FRIEND CANAL COMPANY, Limited.

Second... That the purposes for which it is formed are to acquire, manage, conduct, use, sell, distribute and otherwise dispose of the waters of the North Fork of Snake River, in Fremont County, Idaho for agricultural and domestic purposes; to construct dams, canals, conduits, ditches, flumes headgates and other works for the proper diversion, conduct and distribution of said waters; to acquire, hold and dispose of rights-of-way and other real property needed for such conduct and distribution, and to do any and all acts incident to these or any of these ends.

Third.. That the place where its principal business is to be transacted shall be the Town of Wilford, County of Fremont, and State of Ida.

Fourth... That the term for which it is to exist is Fifty (50) years from and after the date of its incorporation.

Fifth.. That the number of its directors shall be five (5) and that the names and residences of those who are appointed for the first year are;
