ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

THE UNDERSIGNED, acting as incorporator of a corporation under the Idaho Business Corporation Act, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation.

FIRST

The name of the corporation is Home Ventures, Inc.
