ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF

GEM AIRCRAFT, INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we, the undersigned, all citizens of the United States of legal age, have this day voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation in accordance with the provisions of all applicable laws of the State of Idaho, and

WE CERTIFY:

FIRST

That the name of this corporation is

"GEM AIRCRAFT, INC."

SECOND

That the nature of the business and the objects and purposes to be transacted, promoted and carried on are to do any and all of the things herein mentioned as fully and to the same extent as natural persons might or could do in any part of the world, viz:

(a) To engage in the business of engineering, designing, manufacturing, testing, flying, buying, selling, leasing and distributing airplanes, flying machines and aircraft of any and all types whatsoever of every name and nature; to deal in parts, supplies and equipment for said machines; to engage in a general contracting business, buying, selling, and otherwise dealing in all kinds of materials and finished products; to grant or acquire rights or shop rights to or from others of any patent issued, pending or still to be applied for; to acquire by purchase

the following: any attempt to circumvent the United States, in any way,
to the detriment of the interests of the Government of the United States
the United States of America.

(4) If no party is any on either your side, or otherwise, no
 party is any on either, and neither side is making either any or
 if a benefit to any individual, or other corporation.

(c) as to all and everything hereafter, suitable and proper for and incident to the power: enumerated above and for the accomplishment of any of the things so or to be obtained or any of the objects or the accomplishment of any of the powers hereinbefore set forth, either alone or in conjunction with other corporations, firms, or individuals, and as to every other act or deed, thing or thing, or situation or apparatus to be giving out of, or connected with the electrical business or power, or any part or parts thereof, and to comply with the provisions of the individual state laws in which it does business, and to comply with any and all other applicable laws and regulations pertaining thereto.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I, JOHN H. THOMPSON, of the general powers conferred by the laws of the State of Idaho, especially the law pertaining to this type of a corporation, and of the objects and purposes herein set forth, do so expressly provide that this corporation shall also have the following powers, viz:

(a) He make, enter into and perform contracts of every kind for any lawful purpose with any person, firm, association, corporation, municipality, body politic, county, state, or the Federal government.

(b) He purchase or otherwise acquire, lease, assign, mortgage, pledge or otherwise dispose of real and personal property of every kind and nature and wherever situate.

(c) He have one or more offices to conduct his business and promote the objects within and without the State of Idaho, in other states and territories of the United States, or other countries; subject, however, to the laws and limitations of each state, territory or country.

ARTICLE II

That the existence of this corporation is to be perpetual after the time of its incorporation unless sooner dissolved or reincorporated pursuant to law.

ARTICLE III

That the principal place of business and the registered office of this corporation in this state shall be in the City of Nampa, Madison County, State of Idaho.

ARTICLE IV

That the amount of the capital stock of this corporation shall be \$400,000.00, divided into 400,000 shares of common stock of the par value of \$1.00 per share, and 200,000 shares of preferred stock of the par value of \$1.00 per share, with the dividend rate of six per cent per annum, non-cumulative; all of said stock to be held, sold and paid for at such time and in such manner as the Board of Directors may from time to time determine. All stock shall be non-assessable and only the common stock shall have any voting power. All preferred stock shall be subject to call by the

Board of Directors, providing at least three dividends have been paid thereon. All stock, both common and preferred, shall share equally in the assets of the corporation in the event of liquidation.

SIXTH.

That the amount of the capital stock which has been actually subscribed for is the sum of 166,391 shares of common stock for the sum of \$166,391.00, and the sum of 200,000 shares of preferred stock for the sum of \$200,000.00; and the amount of actual cash paid is the sum of \$350,065.00; and following are the names and addresses of the persons, and numbers of shares by whom the same have been subscribed and the amount of cash paid, to-wit:

ARTICLE

That the Board of Directors, subject to the laws of the State of Idaho, shall have the power to repeal and amend the By-Laws and adopt new By-Laws for this corporation. This power may be exercised by a two-thirds majority of the allotted shares of this corporation at any regular meeting of the shareholders or at any meeting specially called for that purpose. By-Laws made by the directors under power so conferred may be altered or repealed either by a two-thirds vote of the Board of Directors or by vote of two-thirds of the allotted shares. The Board of Directors shall not make or alter any by-law fixing their qualifications, classification, term of office, or compensation. Whenever any amendment or any by-law is adopted, it shall be recorded in the book of by-laws immediately after them, and shall not take effect until so recorded.

ARTICLE

That the management of this corporation shall be vested in a Board of not less than three nor more than fifteen directors, as may be fixed by the By-Laws. The directors shall be elected at the annual meeting of the shareholders to be held at the general office of this corporation in said City of Laramie, Idaho, on a day and at the time to be specified in the By-Laws; and until the first election of directors to be held within three months of the filing of these articles, the directors of this corporation shall be: J. 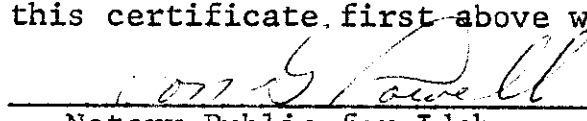

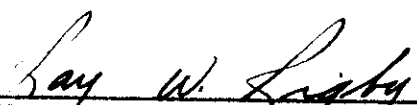
