ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

WESTERN STOCK GROWERS ASSOCIATION, INC.

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KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we, the undersigned, full age citizens of the Unites States of America and all of whom are residents of the State of Idaho do hereby voluntarily associate ourselves together for the purpose of forming a non-profit cooperative association under the provisions of Chapter 10, Title 30, Idaho Code and amendments thereto.

ARTICLE I

The name of this association shall be Western Stock Growers Association, Inc.

ARTICLE II

The purpose or purposes for which this association is formed are:

- (a) To associate its members together for their mutual benefit, and to that end, to engage in the business of producing by purchase, lease, exchange or associate with individuals, other associations, partnerships, or corporations or otherwise acquire lands or rights for grazing cattle, for the use and benefit of its members and not for the purpose of direct gain to the association itself.
- (b) To purchase stock or membership in other grazing or cattle associations. To cooperate with and join with other holders of grazing rights for the operation and use of the same.
- (c) To own, operate and develop recreational facilities.
- (d) To hold, purchase, acquire, lease and convey real and personal property; to borrow for the use and needs of the association and to pledge and/or mortgage real, personal and intangible property of the association as security therefor in any manner permitted by law.

- (e) To do any and all things that may be incident or conducive to the aforesaid objects, or any of them, and exercise the usual powers of corporate bodies.
- (f) To sue and be sued, complain and defend in any court of law or equity.
- (g) To have a corporate seal, which may be altered at the pleasure of the Board of Directors and to use the same by causing it or a facsimile thereof to be impressed or affixed or reproduced or otherwise.
- (h) To appoint such officers and agents as the business of the association shall require and to allow them suitable compensation.
- (i) To make By-Laws not inconsistent with the Constitution or laws of the United States or of the State of Idaho for the management of its property; the regulation and government of its affairs; and for the certification and transfer of its membership certificates.
- amounts as may be provided by the By-Laws of this association.

 Said assessments, as provided by the By-Laws, shall become a lien upon the stock of the members and shall become a lien upon the estate or other personal property of the members situated or located upon the premises of the association.
- (k) The foregoing shall be construed both as objects and powers and the enumeration thereof shall not be held to limit or restrict in any manner the general powers conferred upon this association by the laws of the State of Idaho all of which are hereby expressly claimed.

ARTICLE III

The principal place of business of the association shall be located in Hansen, Idaho, Twin Falls County.

ARTICLE IV

The affairs of the association shall be under the control of a board of directors, consisting of at least 3 directors, the exact number of which shall be set by the By-Laws. Those who shall act as directors to manage the affairs of the association for the first year and until their successors are duly elected and qualified are:

William J. Brockman
Charlotte W. Crockett
Raymond Butler
W. J. Williams
A. E. Kunkel

At the first meeting following the expiration of the one-year period for which the directors designated will serve, and at each annual meeting thereafter, a new Board of Directors will be elected in accordance with the provisions of the By-Laws of the Association and the laws of the State of Idaho.

ARTICLE V

The association shall have the authority to issue 1509 shares of stock without par value. The issuance of any stock shall constitute the membership in the association. No stock can be assigned so that the transferee thereof can by such transfer become a member of the association or a stockholder except by resolution of the Board of Directors and under the regulations as the By-Laws may prescribe.

ARTICLE VI

The By-Laws of the association for the management of its affairs shall be adopted by the members of the association and said members will be empowered to amend or repeal said By-Laws in accordance with provisions thereof.

ARTICLE VII

Each member shall be permitted one vote per office to be filled in the election of any Director or on any other matter at which the share-holders or members of the association are allowed to vote.

ARTICLE VIII

This association shall have perpetual existence.

ARTICLE IX

The address of the initial registered office shall be Route # 1 . Hansen, Idaho.
