ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

IDAHO STATE GRANGE FOUNDATION, INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we, the undersigned persons, all of whom are residents of the State of Idaho, citizens of the United States of America and of full age, have this date voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a nonprofit corporation under the laws of the State of Idaho, and we do hereby make, acknowledge and declare to be our Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE I

The name of this corporation shall be Idaho State Grange Foundation, Inc.

ARTICLE II

This corporation is a nonprofit corporation and shall have no capital stock and shall have no members.

ARTICLE III

The purposes for which the corporation is organized are to receive, hold and distribute money and other property exclusively for charitable, advancement of the arts, and educational purposes, within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the U.S. Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law, as now enacted or hereinafter amended. Hereinafter referred to as the Act.

The Foundation shall have the power to acquire, own, hold, encumber, dispose of and otherwise deal in real and personal property and to engage in and do any and all kinds of activities which a natural person may engage in or do except activities which (a) are not permitted to exempt organizations under the Act, or (b) which are inconsistent with special statutes under which The Foundation is incorporated.

Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from Federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law) or (b) by a corporation contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law).

ARTICLE IV

The period of existence and duration of this corporation shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE V

The location and street address and principal office of this corporation shall be 1524 W. 8th, Meridian, Idaho, and the name of the initial registered agent of said corporation shall be Mary H. Johnson.

ARTICLE VI

Upon the dissolution of this corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code (or corresponding section of any future tax code), or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed by the District Court of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
