ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

of

DEAN VINCENT, INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That we, DEAN VINCENT, HAROLD ROGERS, and GERTRUDE VINCENT, do hereby associate ourselves together as a private corporation, and do hereby adopt and execute these ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION, in triplicate:

ARTICLE I.

The name of this Corporation shall be DEAN VINCENT, INC.

ARTICLE II.

The duration of this Corporation shall be perpetual and unlimited.

ARTICLE III.

The enterprise, business, pursuit and occupation in which this Corporation proposes to engage is as follows:

To loan money, and to take, own, sell, buy, transfer, assign, and pledge evidences of indebtedness, accounts, notes, bonds, mortgages, leases, conditional sales contracts, and other choses in action, for itself or as agent for others, and to enforce the same; to borrow money and pledge its assets and resources to secure the same; to issue and sell bonds, notes, debentures, and other evidences of indebtedness, with or without security, and to do a general financing business; to operate and maintain a general insurance ~~business~~ agency; to buy, sell, exchange, lease, mortgage, and convey real and personal property, and to act as ~~agent~~ agent in the same; to erect, construct, build, maintain, manage and operate houses, apartment houses, office buildings, store buildings, garages, and any

and all other kinds and classes of buildings or constructions of whatsoever nature, and to do a general contracting business; to act as attorney in fact; to mortgage its assets to secure its liabilities, and generally to do anything and everything necessary, convenient, expedient, or desirable to carry on the objects and purposes incident to the business aforesaid, or growing out of the same, or otherwise; to exercise all its corporate functions, and to subscribe for and deal in stock in any corporation to such an extent as now is or may be permitted by law in the jurisdiction in which it operates.

ARTICLE IV.

This Corporation shall have its office and principal place of business in Portland, Multnomah County, Oregon.

ARTICLE V.

The capital stock of this Corporation shall be Fifty Thousand (\$50,000.00) Dollars of Common Stock, divided into five hundred (500) shares of the par value of One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars per share.



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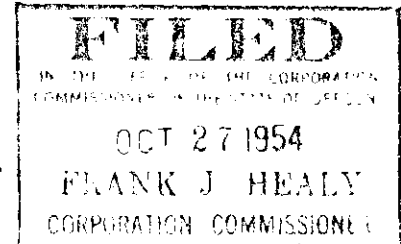

Articles of Amendment
to the
Articles of Incorporation
of



DEAN VINCENT, INC.

Pursuant to the provisions of ORS 57.370 (Section 56, Chapter 549, Oregon Laws 1953) of the Oregon Business Corporation Act, the undersigned corporation adopts the following Articles of Amendment:

1. The name of the corporation is DEAN VINCENT, INC.

2. The following amendment of the Articles of Incorporation was adopted by the shareholders of the corporation on October 23, 1954, in the manner prescribed by the Oregon Business Corporation Act:

Article V of the Articles of Incorporation of this corporation is amended to read as follows.

ARTICLE V

The aggregate number of shares which the corporation shall have authority to issue is two thousand five hundred (2,500) of the par value of one hundred dollars (\$100) each.

3. The number of shares of the corporation outstanding at the time of such adoption was 500, and the number of shares entitled to vote thereon was 500; the number of shares voted for such amendment was 500, and the number of shares voted against such amendment was none

4. The manner in which such amendment effects a change in the amount of stated capital, and the amount of stated capital as changed by such amendment are as follows:

Such amendment effects a change in the amount of stated capital by increasing the stated capital thereof from \$50,000.00 to \$250,000.00.
