Response to Article 8 of the Articles of Incorporation (Non-Profit) of the State of Idaho

Excerpt from *St. Paul's Lutheran Church Constitution*, dated January 17, 2010:

ARTICLE 6

Property Ownership

- 6.01 If this congregation ceases to exist, title to non-disposed property shall be decided by two-thirds majority of the voting membership of St. Paul's Lutheran Church
- 6.02 If two-thirds of the voting members of this congregation, present at a regularly called and conducted special meeting of the congregation, vote to transfer to another Lutheran church body, become independent or relate to a non-Lutheran church body, title to property shall continue to reside in this congregation.
