**ARTICLES OF DISSOLUTION PURSUANT TO IDAHO CODE
SECTION 30-1-1403 OF

Pursuant to the provisions of Section 30-1-1403, Idaho Code, the undersigned corporation, by and through all of its duly elected directors and by and through all of its shareholders, adopts the following articles of dissolution for the purpose of dissolving this corporation.

FIRST: The name of the corporation is Accu-Set, Inc. ("Corporation").

SECOND: The dissolution of the Corporation was authorized pursuant to Idaho Code § 30-1-1402 on the 30th day of September, 1997.

THIRD: The dissolution of the Corporation was approved by the shareholders pursuant to a recommendation by the directors to the shareholders that the Corporation be dissolved as required by Idaho Code § 30-1-1402. The total number of shares of the Corporation outstanding at the time of the authorization of dissolution and as of the date of these Articles was 200 shares, each of which shares was entitled to one vote. All 200 shares voted affirmatively for the dissolution of the Corporation pursuant to Idaho Code § 30-1-1403. No votes were cast in opposition to the dissolution of the Corporation.

FOURTH: The effective date of these Articles of Dissolution of the Corporation shall be September 30, 1997.
