## ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

The undersigned, acting as incorporators of a corporation under the Idaho Nonprofit Corporation Act, adopt the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation:

I.

The name of the Corporation is HEAD INJURED SUPPORT GROUP OF NORTH IDAHO AND EASTERN WASHINGTON, INC.

II.

The Corporation is a nonprofit corporation. The Corporation is irrevocably dedicated to and operated exclusively for nonprofit purposes; and no part of the income or assets of the Corporation shall be distributed to, nor inure to the benefit of, any individual.

III.

The period of its duration is perpetual.

IV.

The purpose or purposes for which the Corporation is organized are:

a. To provide guidance, counsel and support to the families of brain injured persons, howsoever such injury occurred; to make available educational materials on the subject of the brain injured to all interested persons; to work for acceptance and an atmosphere and environment in society for the brain injured; to provide an organization for the common good of families of the brain injured; to lend moral support and encouragement to the

b. Generally, the Corporation may have and exercise all such powers as are by law conferred upon corporations of like character, and, in carrying out its purposes the Corporation may do any and all things necessary thereto and may exercise any and all powers not prohibited by these Articles of Incorporation or law, and not prohibited to non-profit tax-exempt corporations.

v.

The Corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, educational and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law).

VI.

No part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, its members, directors, officers, or other private persons, except that the Corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article IV hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the Corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the Corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the Corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a under Seccorporation exempt from federal tax income

tion 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law) or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law).

VII.

Upon the dissolution of the Corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the District Court of the county in which the principal office of the Corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

VIII.

The address of the initial registered office of the Corporation is 1186 Foothill Road, Moscow, Idaho 83843, and the name of its initial registered agent at such address is John A. Ficca.

IX.

The number of directors constituting the initial Board of Directors of the Corporation is five (5), and the names and addresses of the persons who are to serve as directors until the first annual meeting of members or until their successors are elected and shall qualify are:
