

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

REATA RIDING CLUB

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS that we, the undersigned, hereby associate ourselves together for the intention of forming a non-profit cooperative association, under the provisions of Chapter 10, Title 30, IDAHO CODE, and do hereby execute, subscribe and acknowledge in triplicate, the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I

The name by which this Corporation shall be known is the REATA RIDING CLUB, INC.

ARTICLE II

The objectives: The purpose of this organization shall be to

- A. Achieve better horsemanship.
- B. Foster sportsmanship.
- C. To create better public feelings toward all horse lovers.

ARTICLE III

Place of business: The principal place of business shall be Boise, Ada County, State of Idaho and its officers and members must be residents of Ada County, Idaho. Business and activities of said club may be held anywhere there is a gathering of bona fide members.

ARTICLE IV

Members: The corporation shall have no capital stock, but shall issue membership certificates to each member thereof and the rights and interests of all members shall be equal, with none having the right to acquire a greater interest than another; membership certificates shall not be assignable except by resolution of the board of directors or by any other procedure which the by-laws of said corporation may specify. Members may be minors, except those whose names are subscribed hereto, who are of legal age.

ARTICLE V The term of its corporate existence shall be perpetual.
