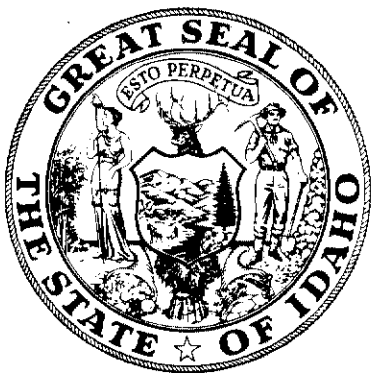

ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT  
TO THE ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION  
OF  
COMMUNITY HOSPITAL OF IDAHO FALLS, INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

1. That the name of the corporation is Community Hospital of Idaho Falls, Inc.

2. That, at a special meeting of the members of the Community Hospital of Idaho Falls, Inc., (hereinafter "Company"), duly called by notice, said notice setting forth the specific purpose of amending the Articles of Incorporation of the Company as hereinafter described, was held at One Energy Drive, Idaho Falls, Idaho, on April 18, 1985.

3. That, at said meeting of the members of the Company, a quorum being present, the following amendment to the Articles of Incorporation of the Company were duly proposed and adopted by the members with the majority of the members entitled to vote thereon voting for said amendments, either in person or by proxy. The number of members entitled to vote on said amendments was ten, with seven members voting for and no members voting against the proposed amendments.

4. That, pursuant to said vote of the members of the Company, Article 4 of the Articles of Incorporation of the Company shall be amended to read as set forth in Exhibit A annexed hereto.



FOURTH: The purpose for which the corporation is organized is the transaction of any or all lawful business for which corporations may be incorporated under the Idaho Non-Profit Corporation Act so long as it does not conflict with § 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, including, but not limited to, the following:

A. To promote the prevention and cure of disease. This includes the erection, equipping, maintaining, managing and leasing of hospitals, convalescent homes and professional schools for nurses and other paramedical personnel.

B. To promote, carry on and further scientific research related to the care of the sick and injured.

C. To participate, so far as circumstances may warrant, in any activity described and carried on to promote the general health of the community.

D. To take, hold, receive and enjoy all real and personal property that may be purchased, given, bequeathed, devised, conveyed or transferred to it, and to hold, use and enjoy the profits, rents and incomes therefrom.

E. To do any and all things which are of a charitable, benevolent, civic, educational and scientific nature, not otherwise prohibited by the Idaho Non-Profit Corporation Act, for the benefit of the community of Idaho Falls, Idaho.
