The undersigned incorporator, desiring to form a professional corporation pursuant to the provisions of the Professional Service Corporation Act, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation:

- ARTICLE 1. Name. The name of the corporation is Austin C. Gillette MD, P.C.



- (i) Receipt of a financial benefit to which he is not entitled,
- (ii) An intentional infliction of harm on the corporation or its shareholders,
- (iii) A violation of section 30-1-833, Idaho Code, or
- (iv) An intentional violation of criminal law.
