ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION JOURNEYS OUTDOOR ADVENTURES, CO.

I the undersigned, acting as the incorporator of a Non-Profit Corporation under the Non-Profit Corporation Law of Idaho, do hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation for Journeys Outdoor Adventure, Co.

ARTICLE 1

The name of the Corporation shall be the Journeys Outdoor Adventure, Co.

ARTICLE 2

Said Corporation is organized for the promotion of whitewater kayaking and outdoor adventures, and to aid in the development of junior level whitewater athletes. It's purpose is to develop river, outdoor, and athletic skills. The underlying goal being the development of leadership and physical fitness, from a program that focuses on self-confidence, self-responsibility, maturity, thoughtfulness, and humbleness.
