

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF THE
Valley
TETON POWER & MILLING COMPANY, Limited.

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Pursuant to the Laws of Idaho, the undersigned, a majority of whom are bona fide residents of the State of Idaho, have adopted, and by these presents do adopt, the following Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE 1.

The name of the corporation shall be the Teton Power & Milling Company, Limited. Valley

ARTICLE 11.

The purpose for which this corporation is formed is to construct, build, own and operate flour mills and an electric power plant, and grain elevators; and particularly to establish and carry on and conduct the business of manufacturing for sale flour and other milling products, and to handle and sell general milling products at wholesale and retail; to purchase, sell, acquire and dispose of wheat and other grain, flour and all kinds of mill produce; and also to establish, maintain and conduct an electric lighting and power plant, and grain elevators, and to own, lease or otherwise acquire the necessary real estate for carrying on said business; and to buy and sell any and all kinds of electrical supplies and devices necessary for said business.

ARTICLE 111.

The place where the principal business of this corporation is to be transacted is Driggs, Fremont County, State of Idaho.

ARTICLE IV.

The term for which this corporation is to exist shall be fifty years from the date of its incorporation.

ARTICLE V.

The number of its directors shall be five, three of whom shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business and exercise the powers of the corporation. The names and places of residence of the directors and other officers appointed for the ensuing year

are: W. William Taylor, Thomas R. Wilson, Jens H. Jeppesen, Don C. Driggs and James M. Sewell, directors, W. William Taylor, president, Thomas R. Wilson, vice president, Don C. Driggs, treasurer and Jens N. Jeppesen secretary, all of Driggs, Fremont County, State of Idaho.

ARTICLE VI.

The amount of the capital stock shall be twenty-five thousand dollars, divided into twenty-five thousand shares of one dollar each.

ARTICLE VIII.

The stockholders shall not be individually liable for the debts or obligations of the corporation.
