ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

0F

YOUTH WITH A MISSION IDAHO, INC.

WE, the undersigned, have voluntarily associated outselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under the General Nonprofit Corporation Law of the State of Idaho, and we hereby certify the following:

Ι.

That the name of this corporation is YOUTH WITH A MIS-STON IDAHO, INC.

II.

- A. That the specific and primary purposes for which this corporation is formed are as follows:
 - 1. To establish a religious service organization for the promotion of the Gospel of Jesus Christ throughout the world.
 - To present an open door for sacrificial service to young men and young women with gifts, talents and/or material assets which they may desire to dedicate to the extension of world wide missions.
 - 3. To encourage enlistment into the missionary service of volunteers from every vocation either as assistants to Gospel missionaries or as "goodwill ambassadors" preparing the way for the Gospel Ministry.
 - 4. To increase missionary giving and encourage volunteers for the mission field through the promotion of new missionary projects such as church buildings, schools, homes and orphanages.
 - 5. To build an organization available to evangelical denominations and offer a service elastic enough to include men and women of all ages who are interested in promoting the Gospel message in foreign lands.
- B. The general purposes or powers are as follows:
 - 1. To lease, purchase, hold, have, use and take possession of and enjoy in fee simple or otherwise any personal or real property necessary for the uses and purposes of the corporation, and to sell, lease, mortgage, deed in trust, alien or dispose of the same at the pleasure of the corporation, and for the uses and purposes for which said corporation is formed, and to buy and sell real or personal property and to apply the proceeds of sale, including any and all income, to the uses and purposes of the corporation.
